

ABSTRACT

This paper is an assessment of farmer's awareness of the effects of environmental conditions on their agricultural crops in Trinidad. This study was undertaken to investigate the knowledge farmers in East Trinidad have concerning the environment and its effects on their crops.

It was conducted using questionnaires filled out by thirty farmers in the Eastern areas of Trinidad. The responses obtained gave an insight of what farmers knew about the environment in relation to their crops and productivity. Some information was also obtained on Agricultural Extension Services and how they can benefit the farmers.

Generally most farmers were aware of the environmental conditions but could not relate how these conditions can affect the productivity of their crops.
