

# South rings in Panorama '87

PANORAMA 1987 is here. From 9 a.m. today the sweet sound of steel will emanate from Skinner Park, San Fernando, as the Pan-Round-Neck and South/Central Zonal preliminaries begin.

The band with the honour of playing the first notes in this year's Panorama competition is former pan-round-neck champion Pan Jammers of Santa Cruz. Reigning festival champs TCL Skiffle Bunch will be the last band to face the judges in this category.

Defending South/Central champions Fernandes Vat 19 Fonclaire will meet the challenge of 18 bands from the zone.

Panorama continues tomorrow morning, at the Queen's Park Savannah,



from 9 o'clock, with the staging of the North/East preliminaries.

Thirty-seven bands will face the judges, including East Zone champion Nutones, North Zone '86 winner Phase II Pan Groove and '86 national Panorama champions Catelli Trinidad All Stars.

Judges are Junior Howell, Jocelyn Pierre, Merle Albino-De Coteau, Kenneth Blackman and Lindy Ann Bodderritch.
