above the rest, in a land where good steelbands are a dime a dozen.

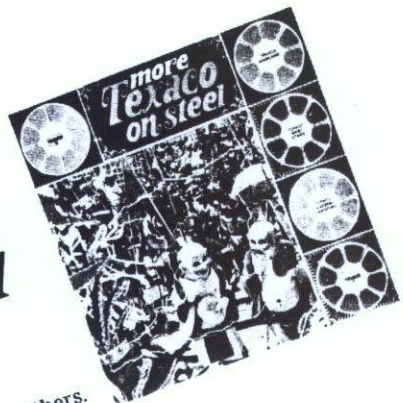
