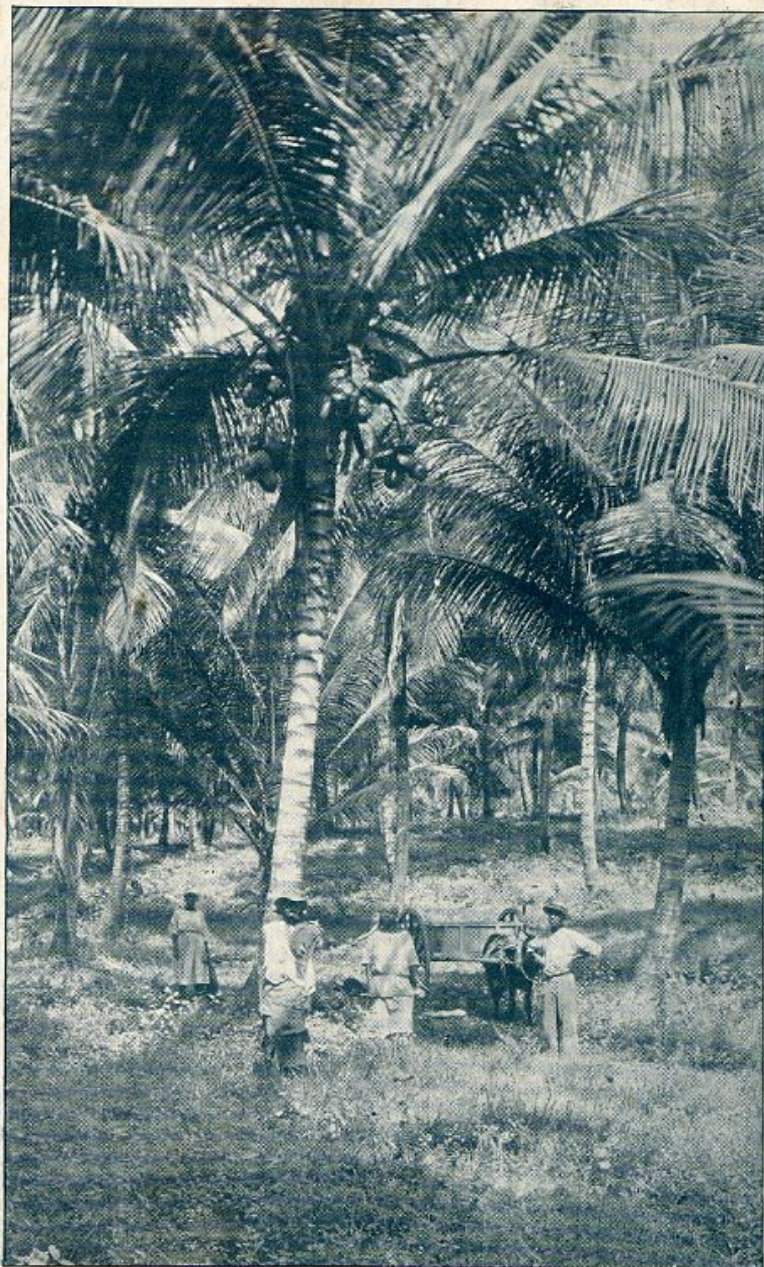




Trinidad. Coconut Grove.

The shore excursions to Santa Cruz and Maraval Valleys, the Pitch Lake and the special excursion to Gasparée Island where the famous Gasparée Caves are located, were highly enjoyed by the passengers.

The "Reliance" sailed for La Guayra February 5, at midnight, where she will arrive Sunday morning.
