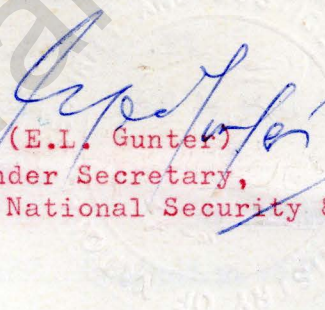

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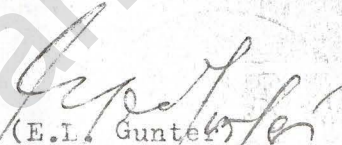

I wish to ask your formal permission for myself, my wife and our three children to enter and reside in Jamaica. We are British subjects and hold British passports.

I am an author by profession and during an assignment in Jamaica last year I acquired a piece of land in the Red Hills area where, subject to your permission to enter the country, we plan to build a house. My books are published in both Britain and the United States and I am therefore one of those useful animals, a dollar earner. I shall also come as the accredited correspondent of one or two English newspapers.
