This means Curepe will be milked dry of youths on Carnival

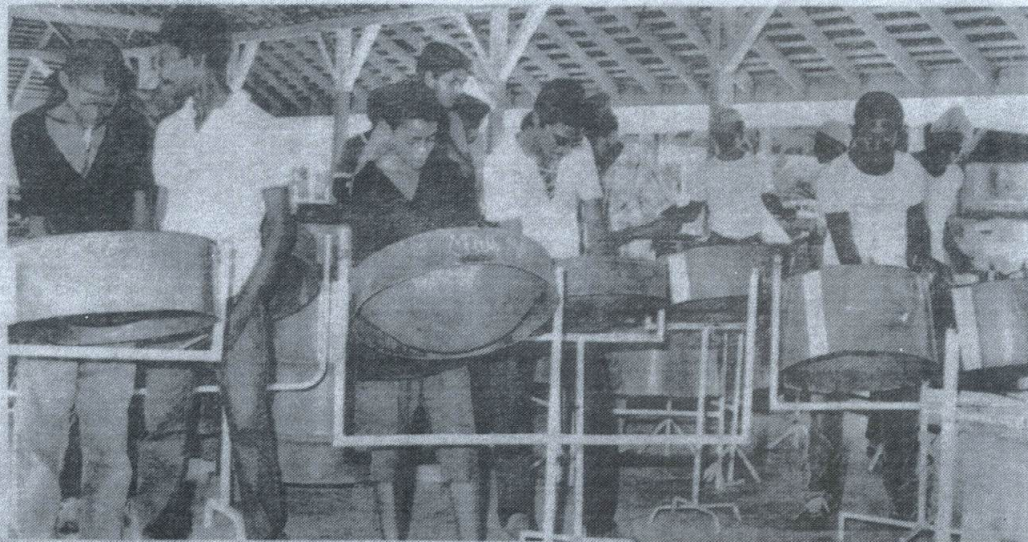
Relations Officer Abdul Hamid-Anthony Reid, said.
