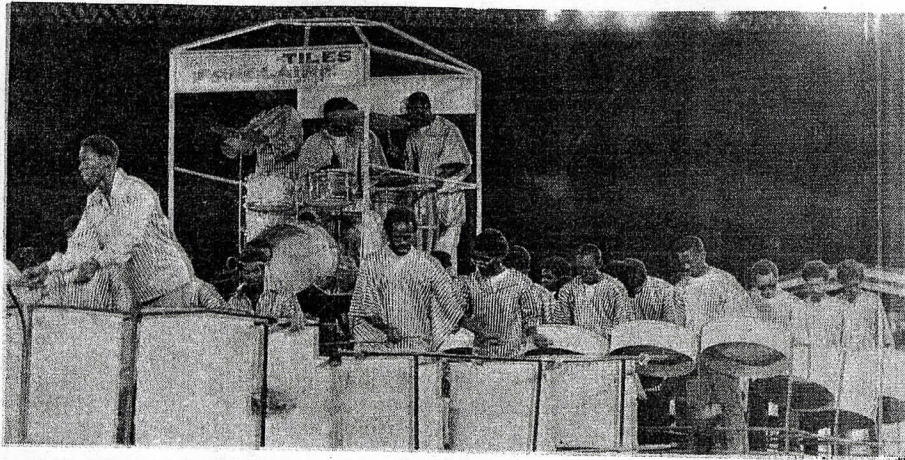




MOSCO TILES FONCLAIRE.
