PART 1: GENERAL INTRODUCTION

1. Introduction.

The sample survey project for session 1957-58 was conducted by a team of six postgraduate students, namely Alexander, Amazigo, Barrie, MacLean, Myers and York. The team met regularly during the first term under the chairmanship of Dr. Jolly to discuss the problems which arose in the organisation of the survey.
