ANTILLEANS DROP A DOUBLE 'BOMB' IN SAN FERNANDO

THE Antillean All Stars scored a double victory in the two "Bomb" competitions organized by Businessmen in San Fernando yesterday morning.

Antillean All Stars won the Hoytes "Bomb" competition organized by John Hoyte Auto Paint Shop and the Cold Cold "Bomb" contest run by the Mucurapo Street Carnival Committee. All Stars ran second in the "Pan Round De Bend" competition organized jointly by the Southern Division of the Trinidad and Tobago Chamber of Industry and Commerce and the South Trinidad Chamber of Industry and Commerce.
