### ANAESTHETICS AND INTENSIVE CARE CASE REPORTS

This book consists of twenty case reports. The cases were collected over a period of approximately six years. The patients discussed were either patients admitted to the Intensive Care Unit or for whom anaesthesia was provided or both.
