STEELBAND

THE Carnival spirit will grow fiercer this morning as thousands are expected to turn out to witness the year's first major competition - Steelband Panorama.

Fifty two of the nation's top pan sides will gather at the Queen's Park Savannah and

flaunt their latest arrangements all seeking a place in the semi-finals.

While ears will be attuned to the drums, eyes will be feasting on the wild threads that create another attraction at Panorama.

And judging from reports reaching us,

the crowd is going to be bigger than ever this morning.

As Kitchener says: "We go make up for all that we lose this year Carnival."

Won't you be there?

Over 50 bands battle for more than \$11,000

THIS year the Carnival Development Committee is awarding \$11,150 in Panorama prizes, not including the appearance fees given to each band participating in the three contests.

Panorama winner gets \$2,500. The other six bands in the finals will receive, in order of merit: \$1,800, \$1,300, \$900, \$500, \$400 and \$300. And there's an appearance fee of \$500 for each of these bands.

Prizes

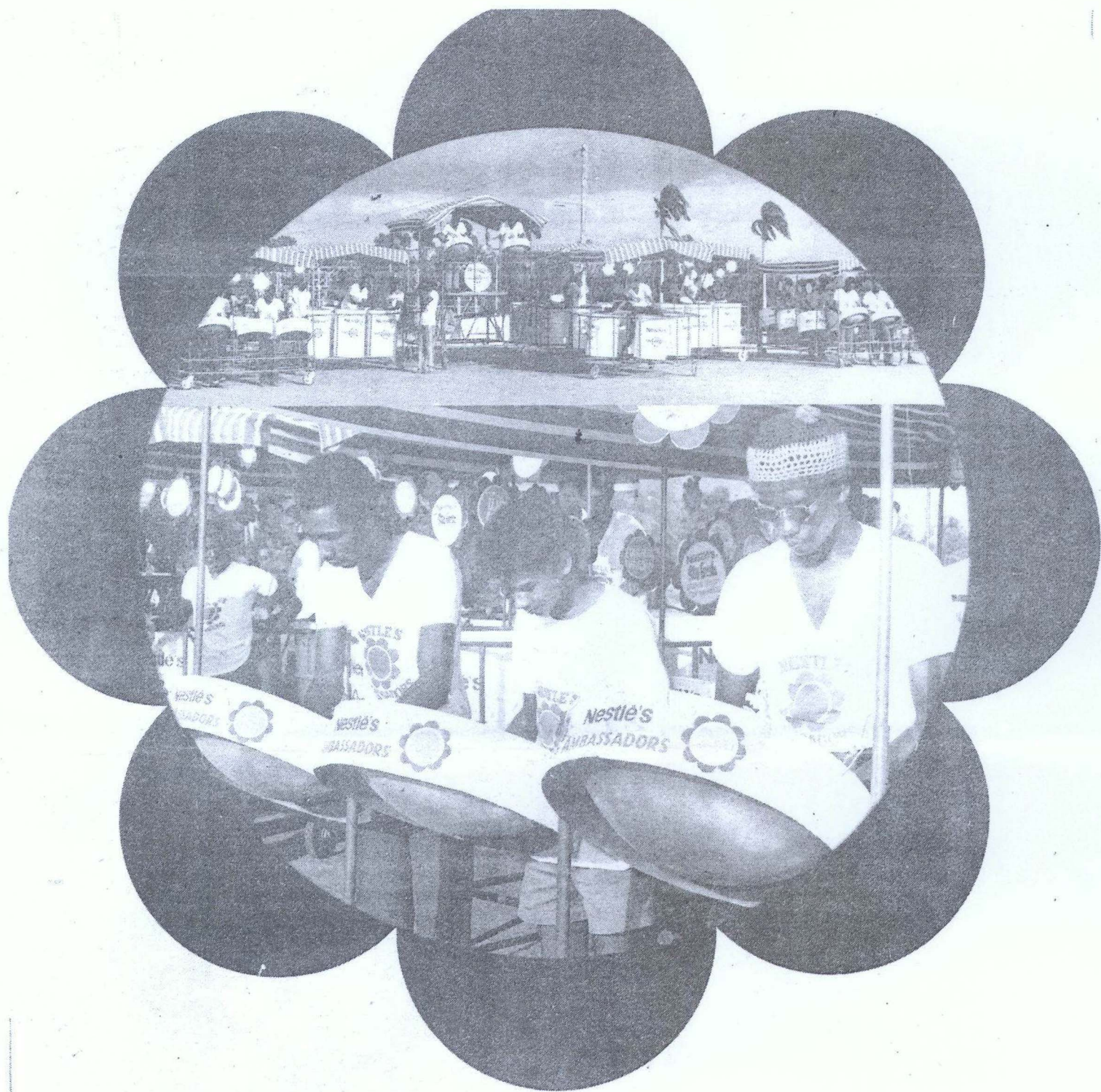
In the semi-finals there are prizes for best dressed steelbands worth \$300, \$200 and \$150. Plus an appearance fee of \$400 for each steelband.

First prize in today's preliminaries is \$1,000 second - \$800, third - \$500 and fourth - \$300.

There's a token prize of \$200 for the band judged to be the most promising, and an appearance fee of \$150 for each band.

CDC will pay costs of moving pans

STEELBANDS need not worry about the costs of transporting pans to the venue of the Panorama preliminaries and semi-finals. The CDC will pay costs to bands based on the following rates. Bands in Port-of-Spain - \$60; Bands within a radius of 10 miles from Port-of-Spain - \$120; Bands within a radius of between 10 and 20 miles from Port-of-Spain - \$150; Bands over a radius of 20 miles but less than 40 miles from Port-of-Spain - \$180; Bands over a radius of over 40 miles from Port-of-Spain - \$325.

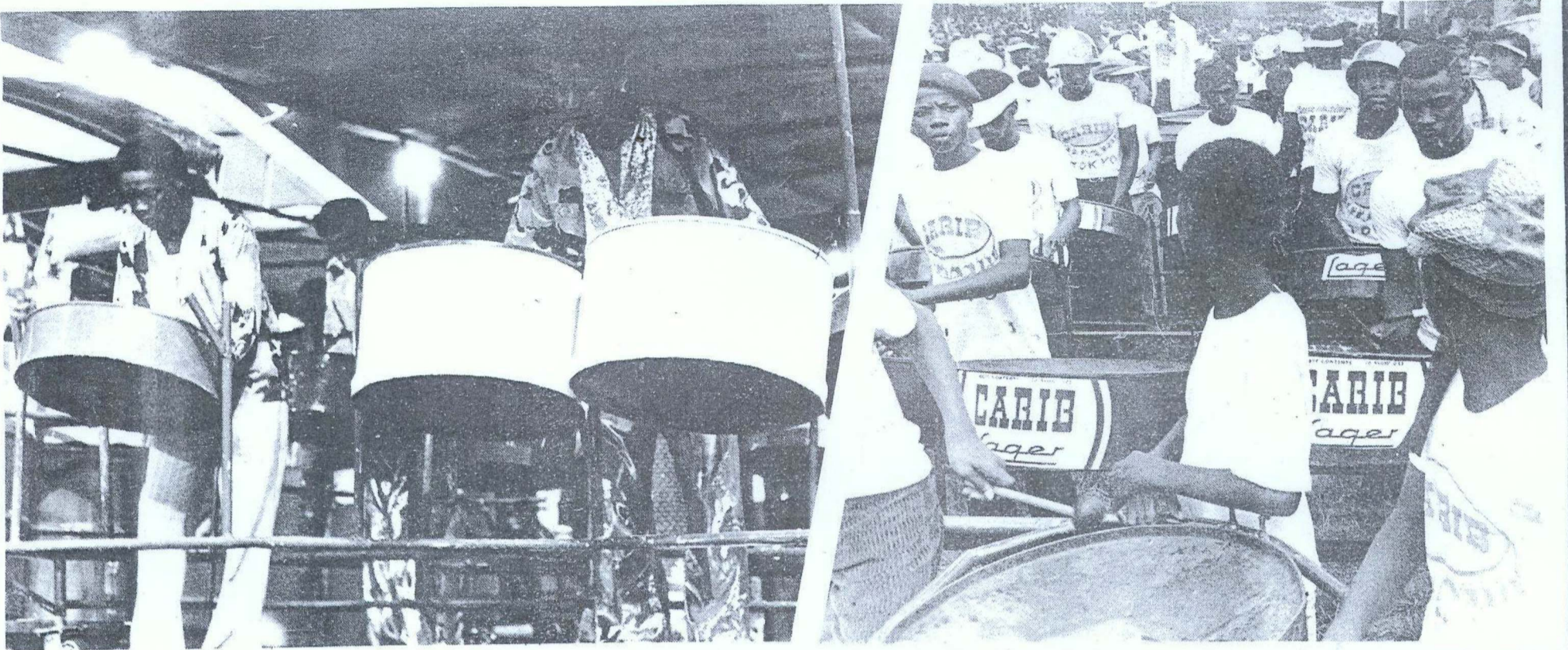
