

All Stars beat way into Panorama semi-finals

TRINIDAD All Stars is the only unsponsored steelband of the 12 selected for the Panorama semi-finals to take place on Friday.

The other bands are: Angostura Starlift; Chase Manhattan Savoy; Coca-

Cola Silver Stars; Esso Tripoli; Forsyth Hilanders; Old Oak Casablanca; Sandbach City Syncopators; Shell Invaders; Solo Harmonites; Texaco Dixieland; and West Indian Tobacco Gay Desperadoes.

For appearing in the semi-finals each of the bands will be paid \$200.

Of these, seven semi-finalists will be selected for the Dimanche Gras show on Sunday, for which another \$200 appearance

fee will be paid.

In addition the seven bands will receive cash prizes as follows: First - \$1,000; second - \$750; third - \$500; fourth - \$350; fifth - \$250; sixth - \$150; seventh - \$100.

Meanwhile Esso Tripoli has won the \$200 prize for the Best-Dressed-Steelband at the preliminaries on Sunday. Following were Coca Cola Silver Stars, \$150 and West Indian Tobacco Gay Desperadoes, \$100.

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
