

'Pan is Beautiful Three' begins at Complex tonight

THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO biennial Steelband Music Festival "Pan is Beautiful Three" begins tonight with nine bands appearing in the first of the preliminary rounds.

All rounds of the competition will be held at the Jean Pierre Sports Complex starting at 7 p.m. The preliminaries will continue through the weekend, ending on Sunday 21 October. Ten bands will appear on Saturday and another ten on Sunday.

Altogether 29 bands and 37 soloists will compete. The semi-finals will be held on 29 and 30 October and Finals on Saturday, November 3.

All the conventional bands will receive a \$5,000 performance fee for both the preliminaries and semi-finals. Old time steelbands will receive a \$2,500 appearance fee for the preliminaries and a \$5,000 appearance fee for the finals.

There will be no semi-final in the Pan Around the Neck Competition. Conventional bands will receive \$10,000 as an appearance fee for the finals.

Pan Trinbago has issued a table of bands, with their tune of choice, calypso of choice, their leaders, arrangers and conductors. The Test piece for all conventional bands is "Cosi Fan Tutte" by Mozart and "Nocturne" in E by Chopin for Old Time Steelbands.

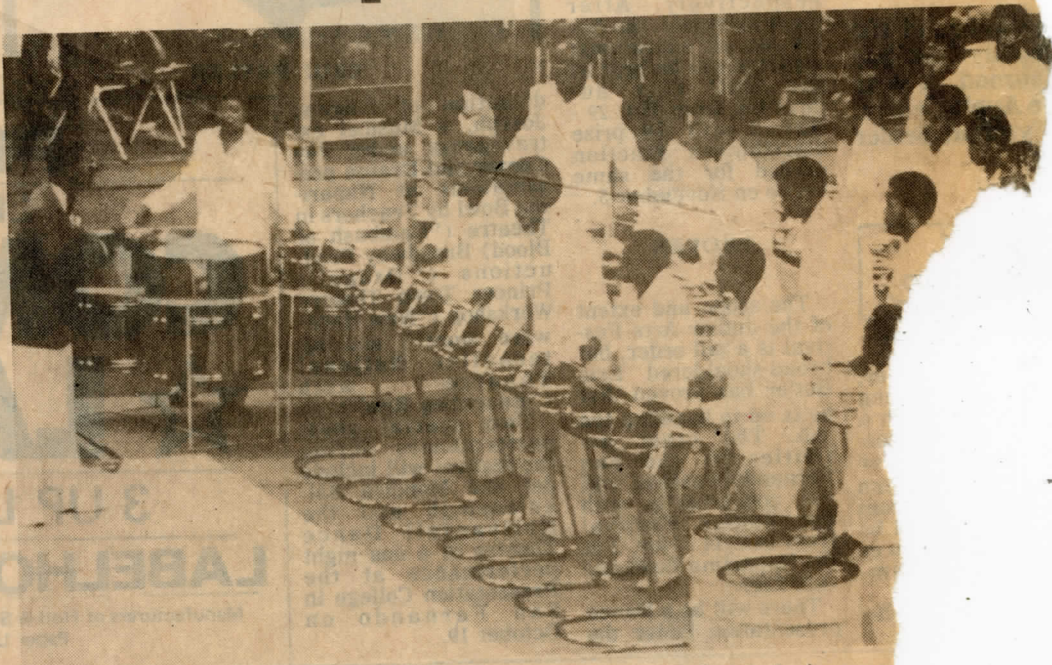
