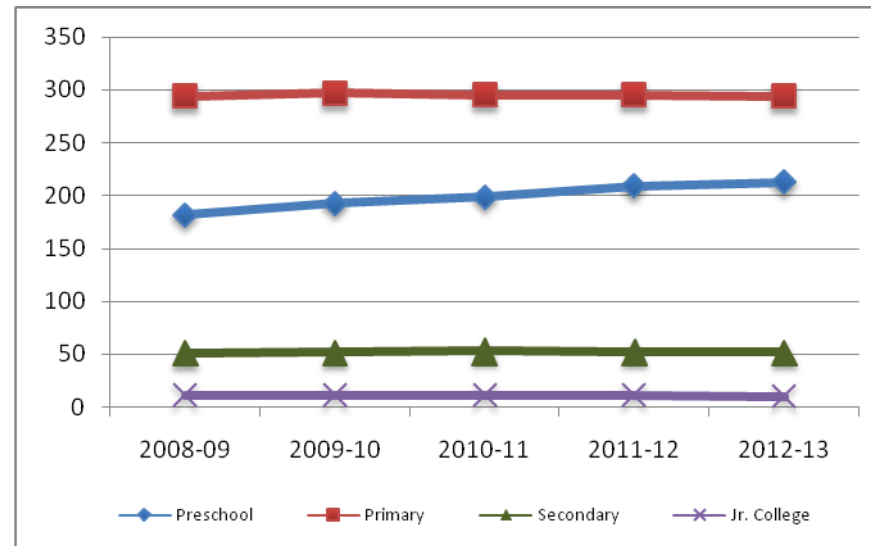

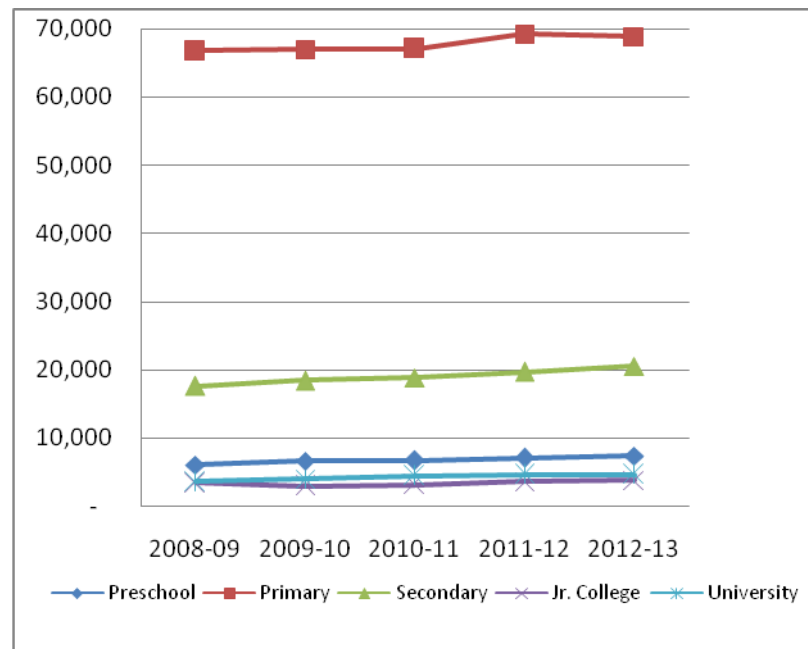

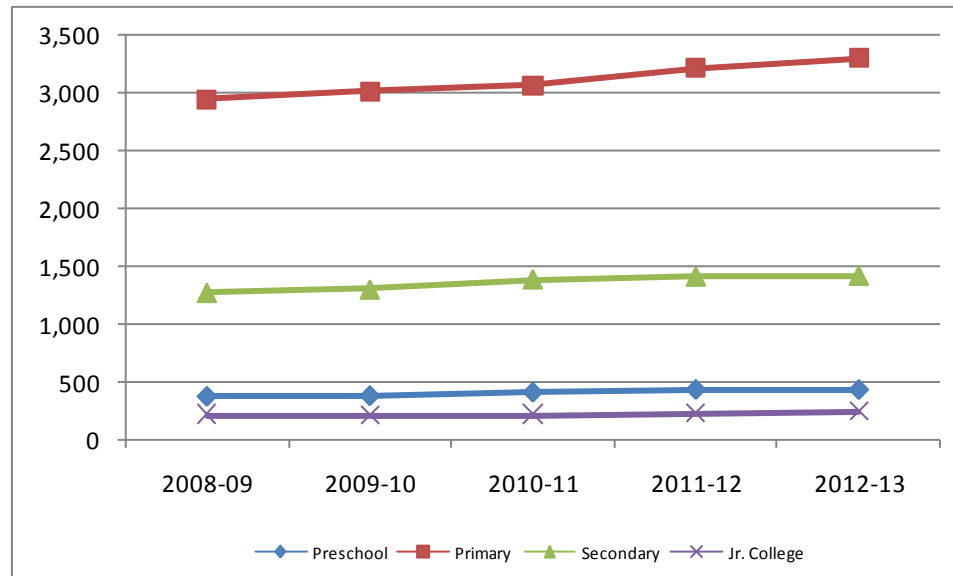

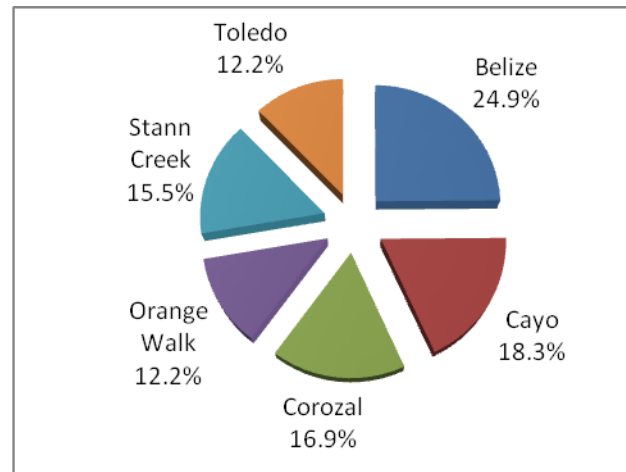

Figure 4: Distribution of Preschool by District 2012-13





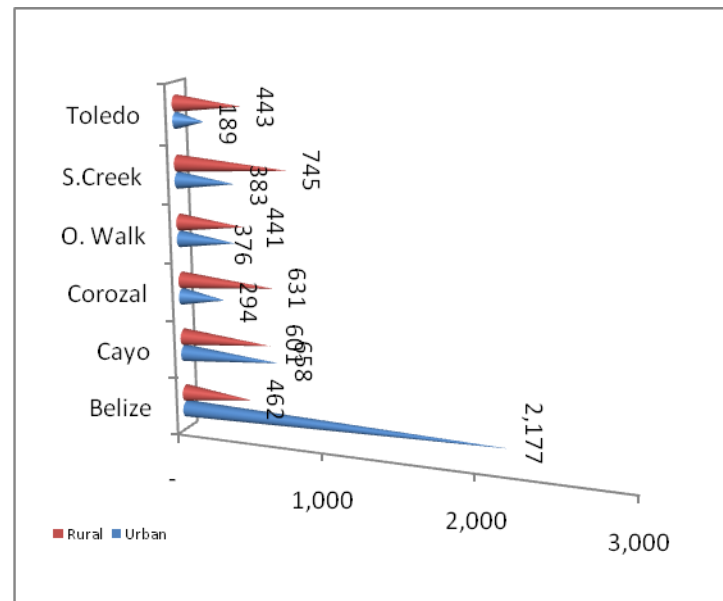

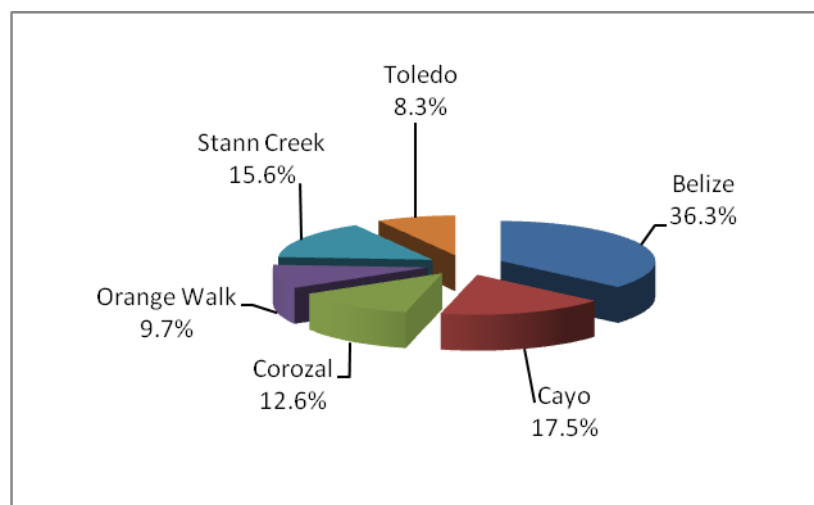

Figure 7: Distribution of Primary School by District and Urban/Rural Location 2012-13

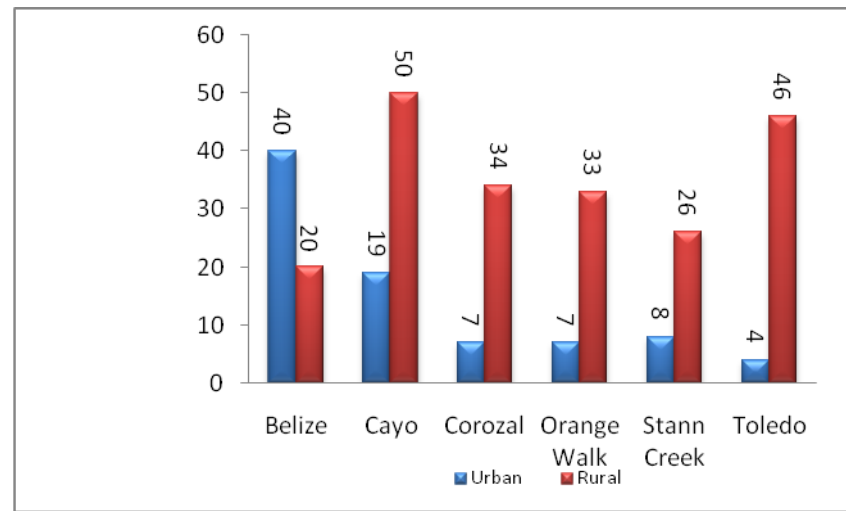
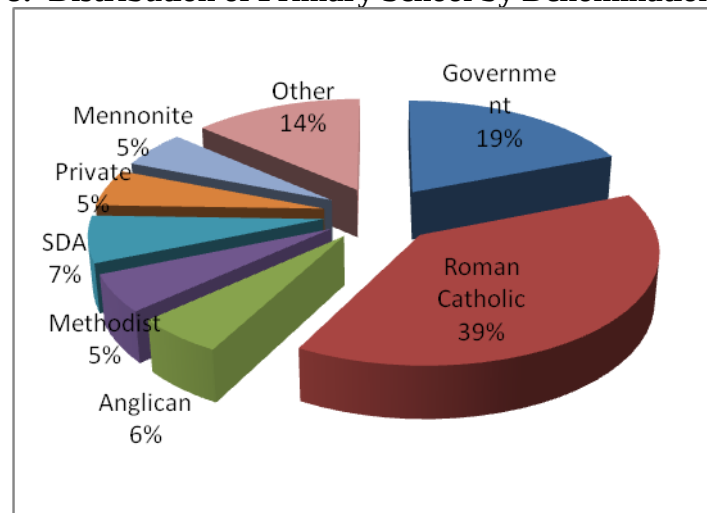


Figure 8: Distribution of Primary School by Denomination 2012-13

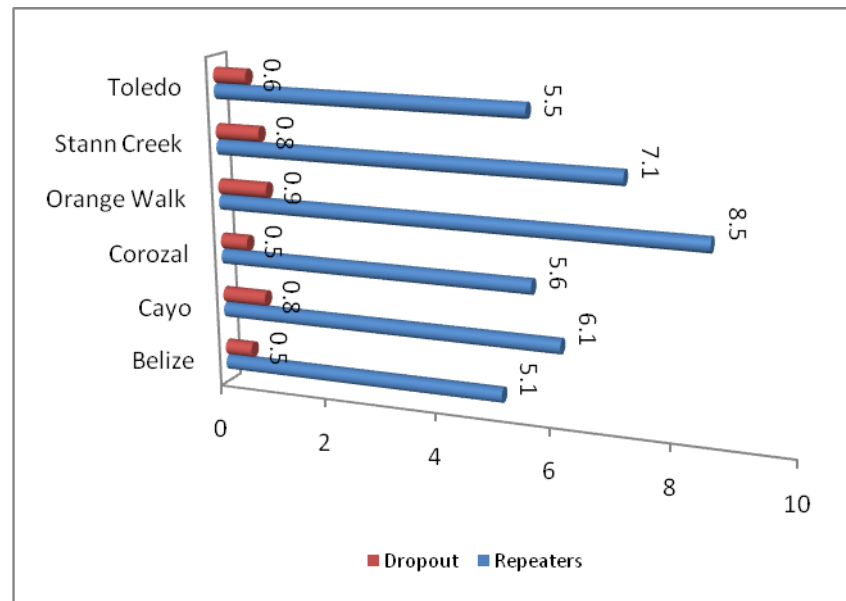

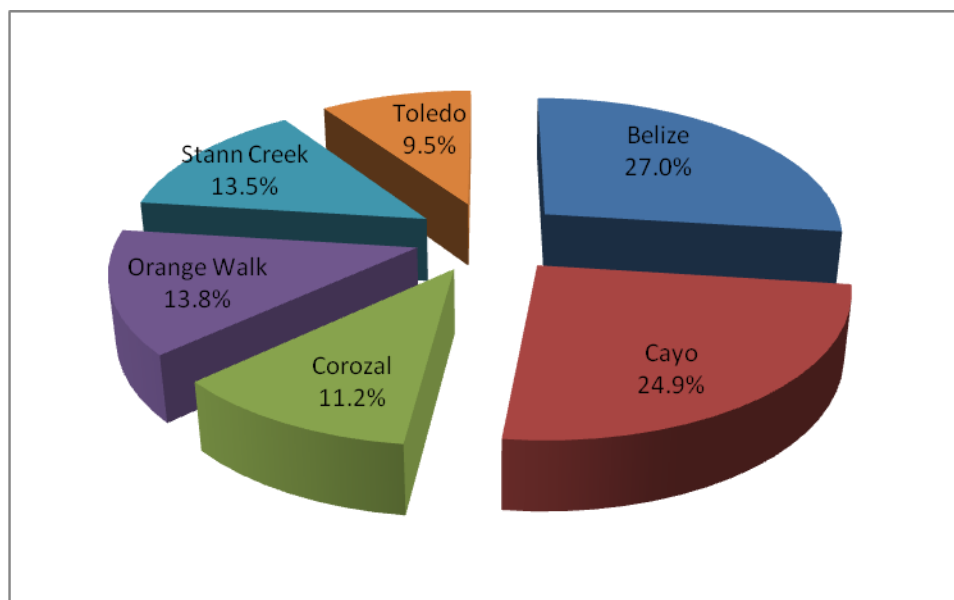

Figure 10: Distribution of Primary School Teachers by District 2012-13

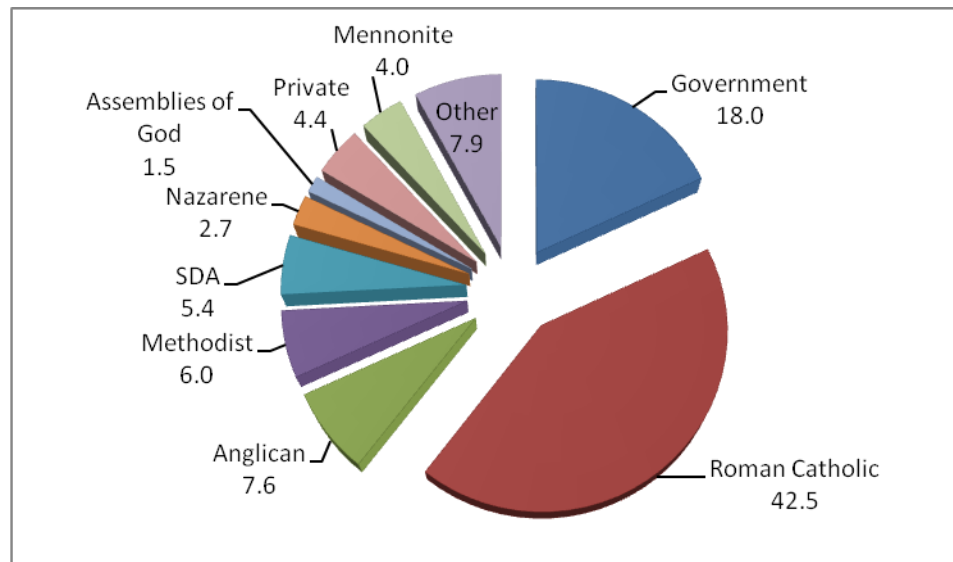

Figure 12: Distribution of Secondary Schools by District and Urban/Rural Location 2012-13

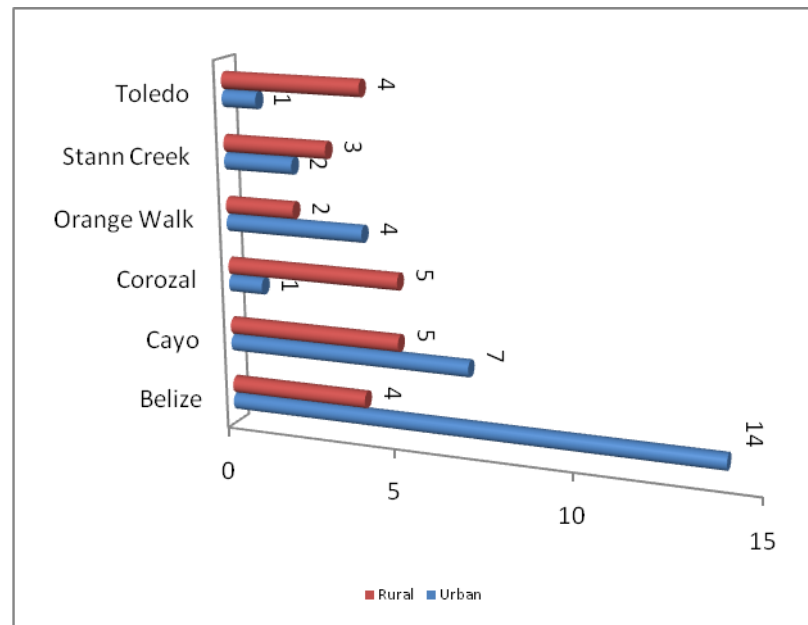


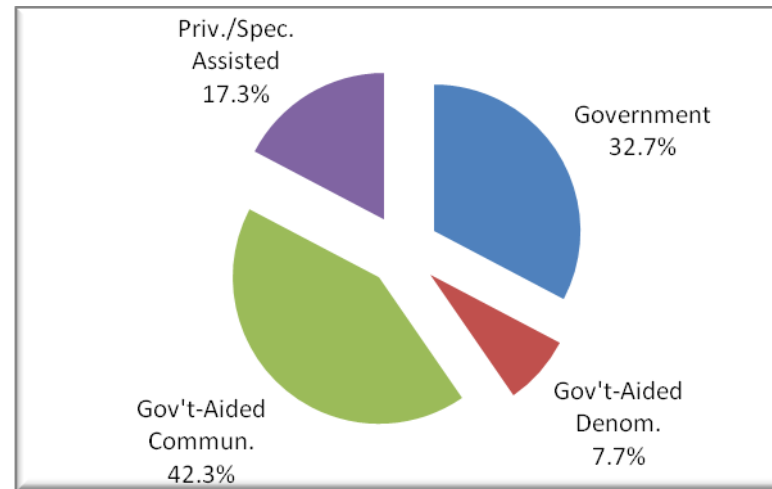

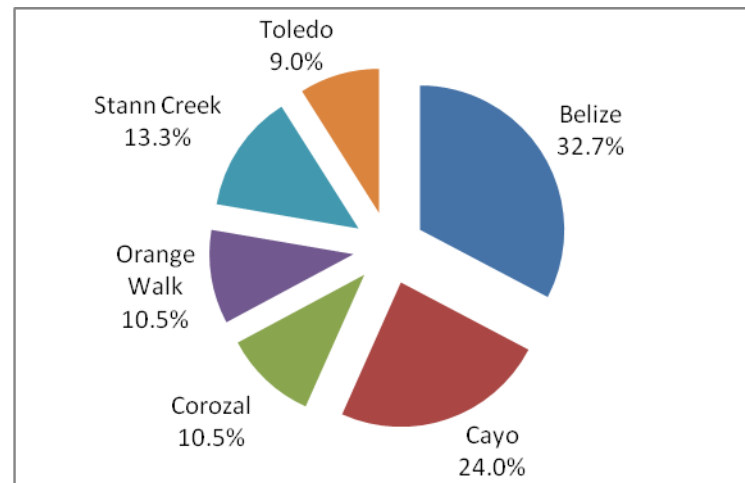

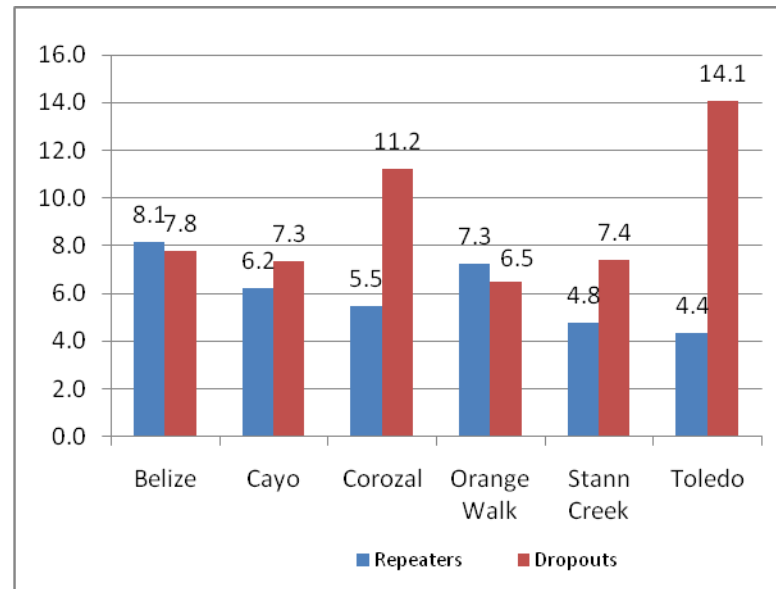

Figure 16: Qualifications of Secondary School Teachers 2012-13

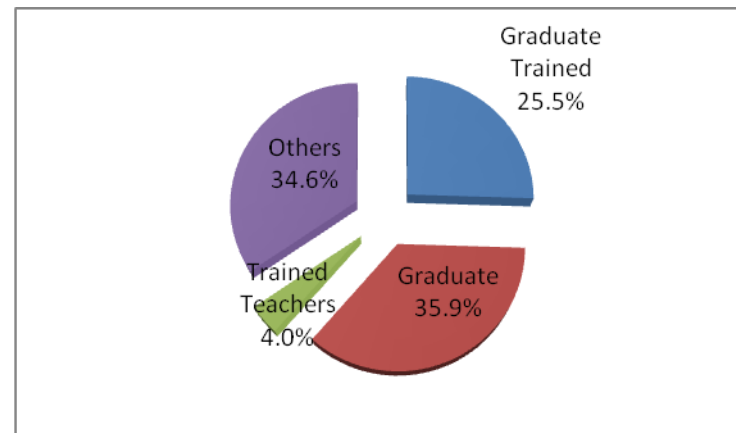
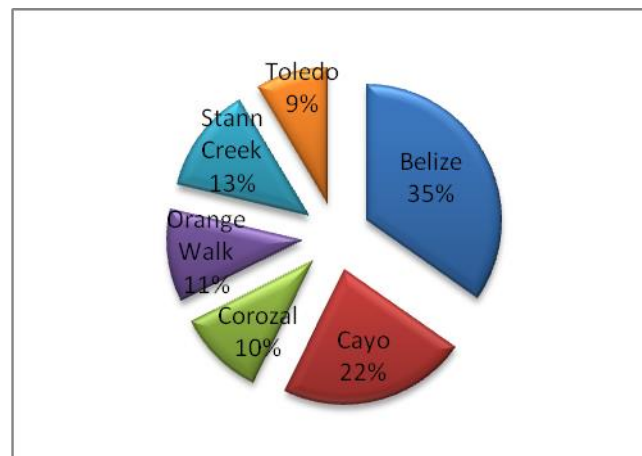


Figure 17: Distribution of Secondary School Teachers by District 2012-13

Figure 18: GOB Recurrent Expenditure by Ministry 2012-13

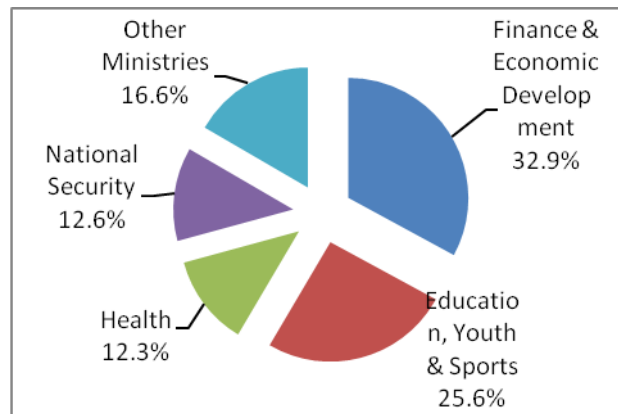


Figure 19: Ministry of Education Recurrent Expenditure by Sub-sector 2012-13

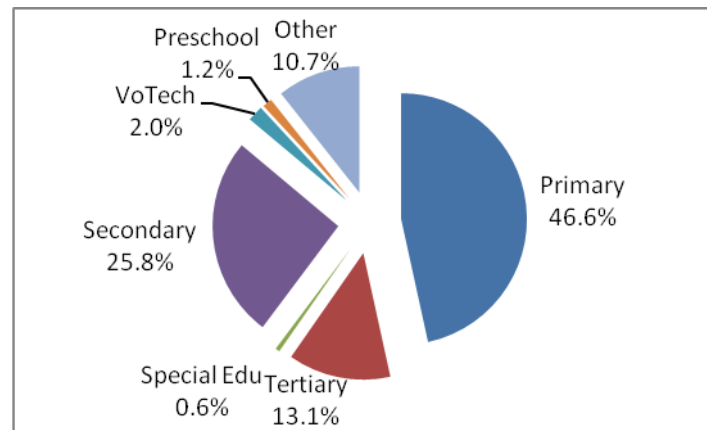
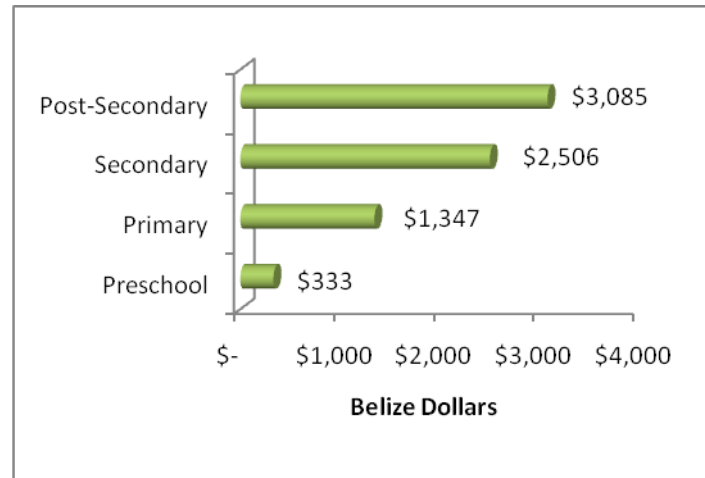




Figure 20: MOES Recurrent Spending Per Student by Level of Education 2012-13

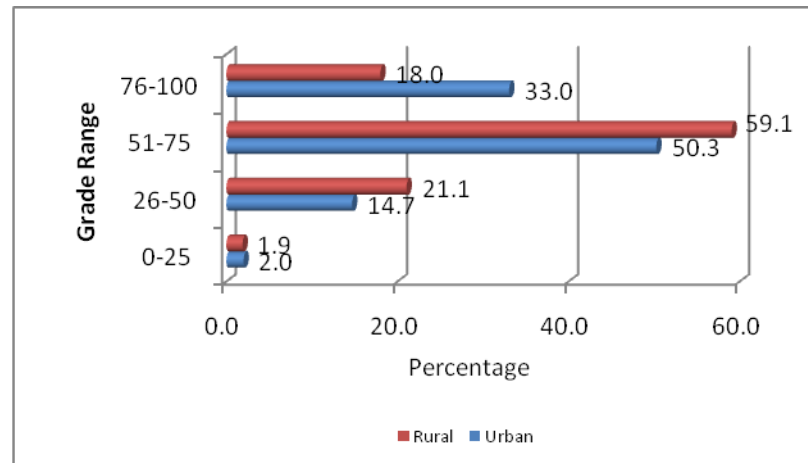

Figure 22: Percentage of Urban and Rural Candidates' CSEC with Satisfactory level of performance in English A 2008 to 2012

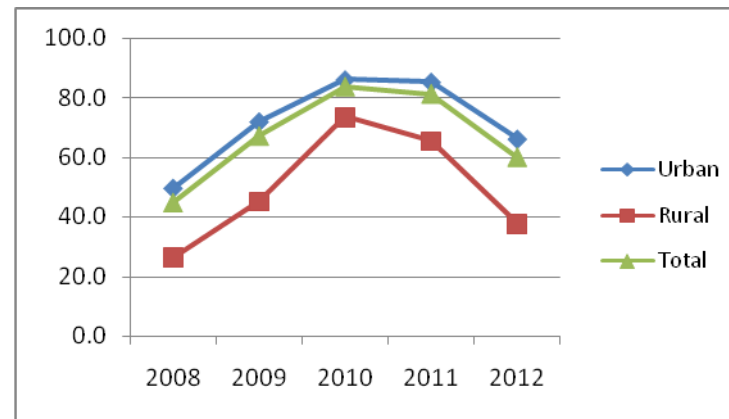
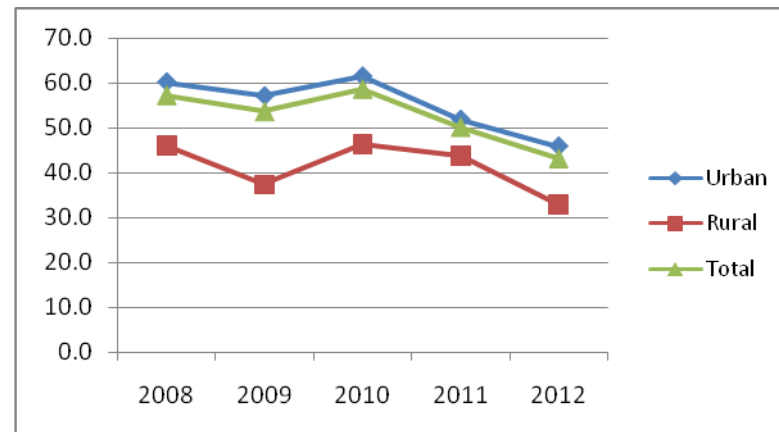


Figure 23: Percentage of Urban and Rural Candidates' CSEC with Satisfactory level of performance in Mathematics 2008 to 2012

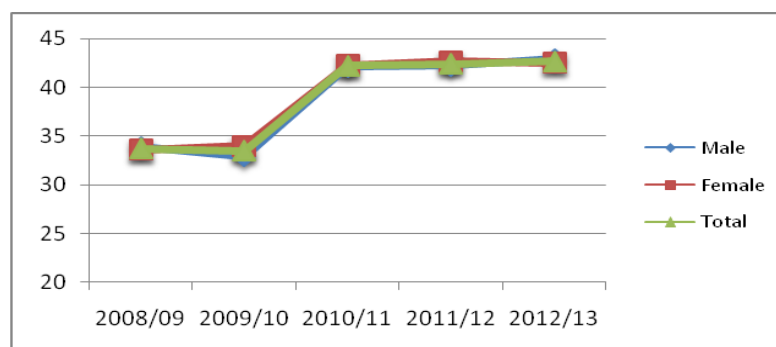

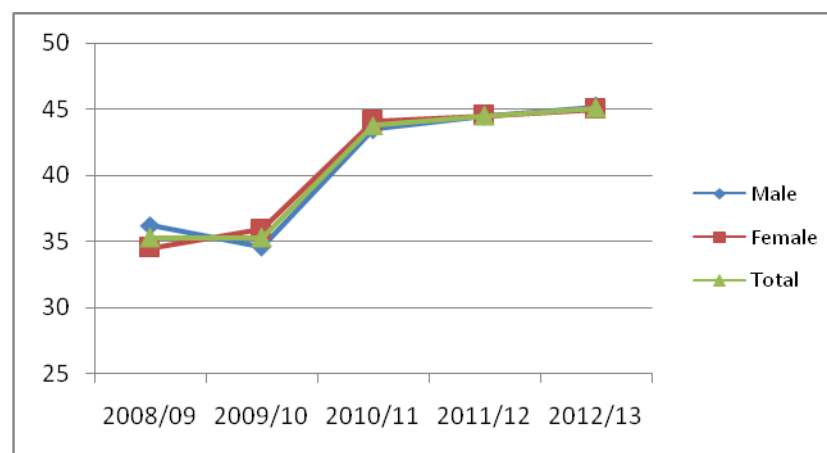

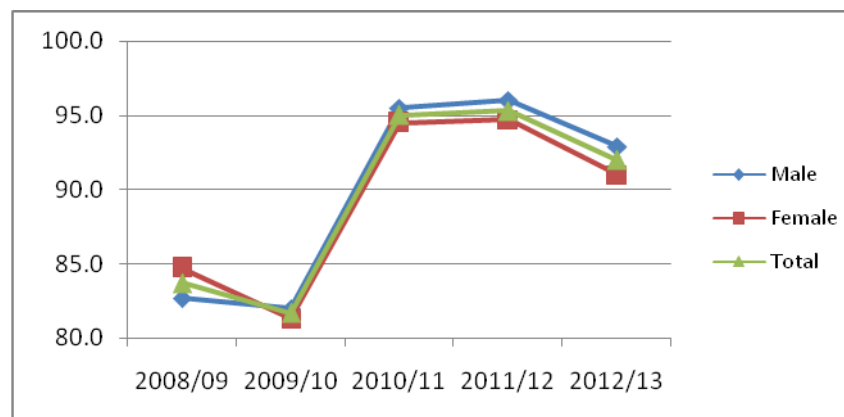

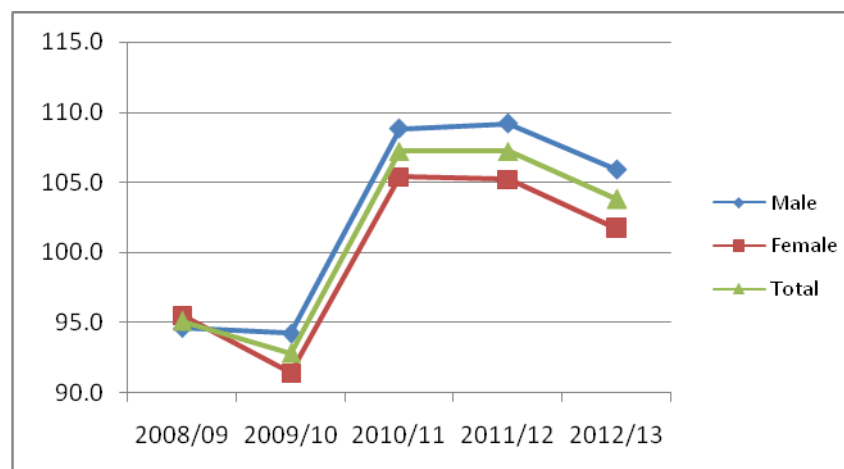

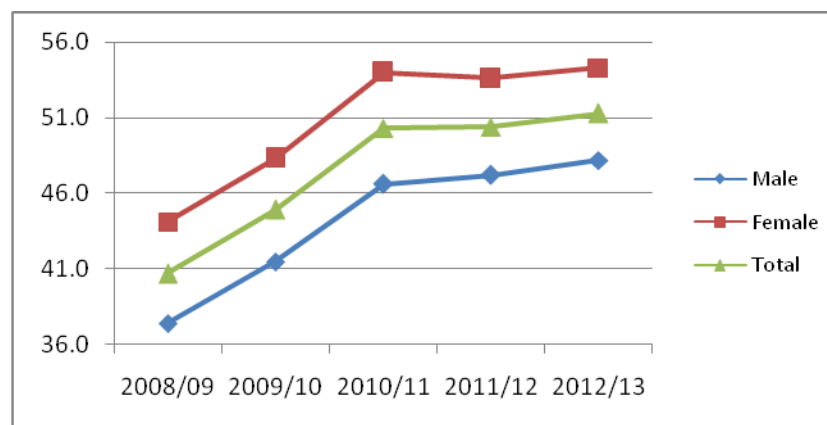

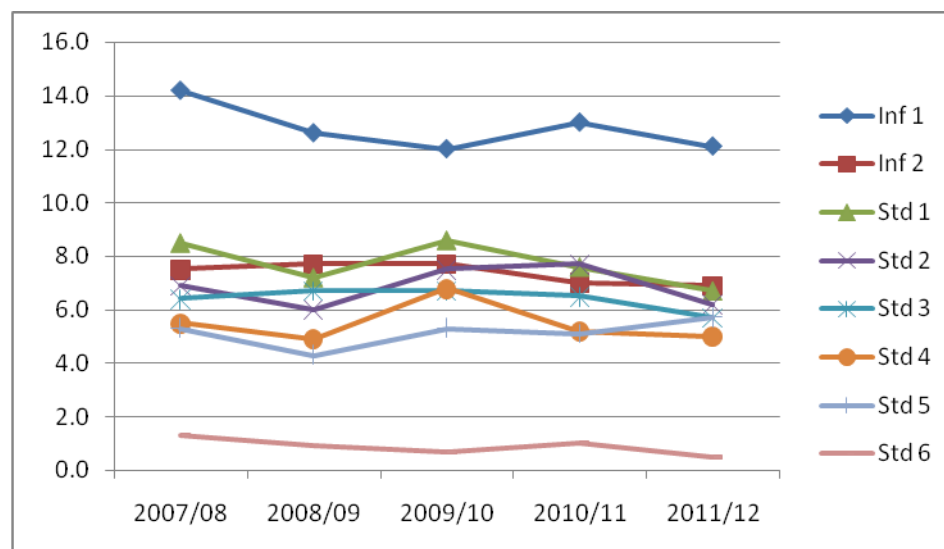

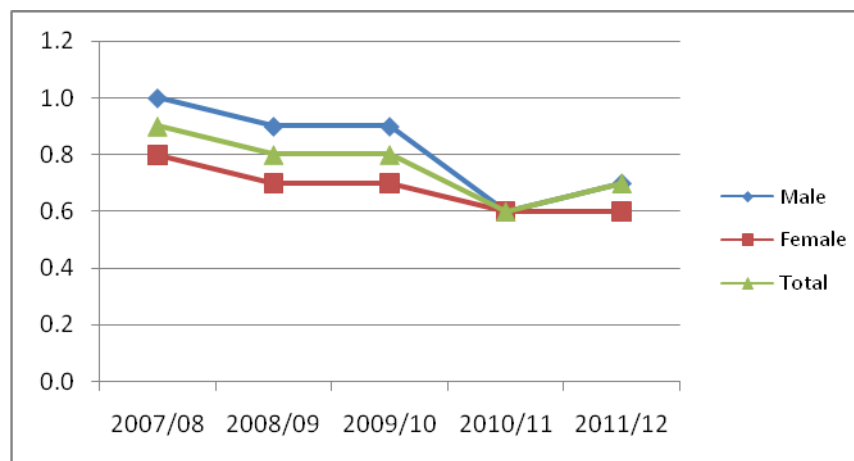

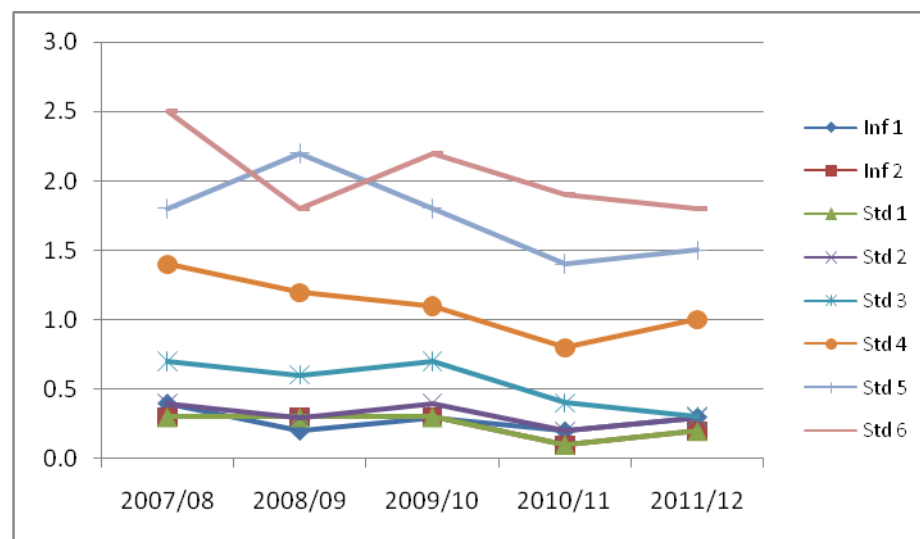

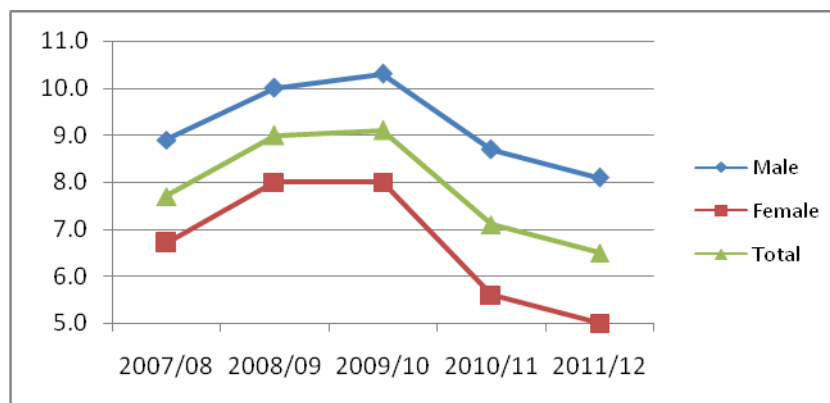

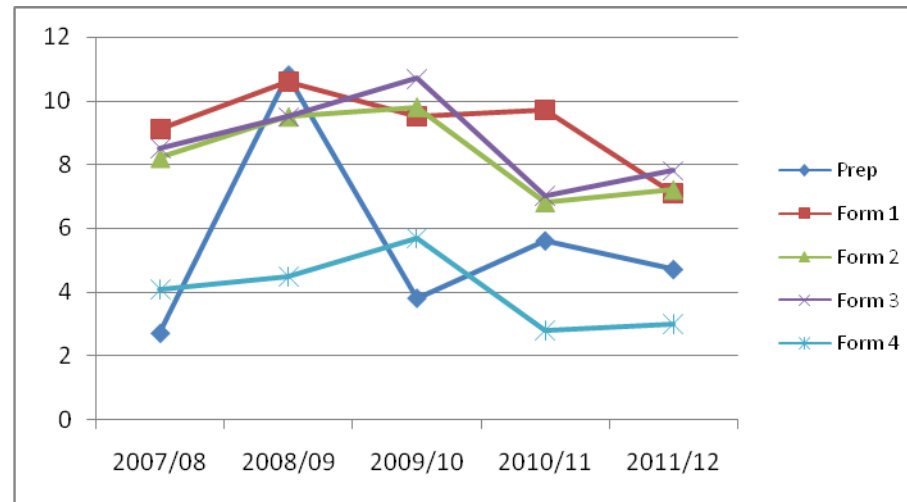

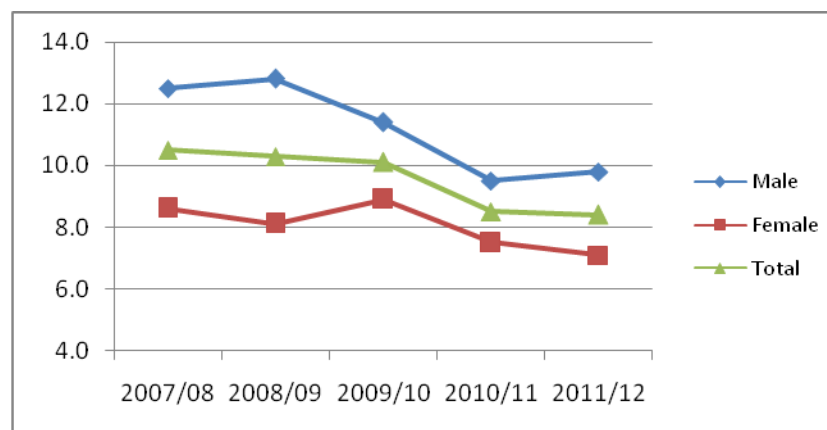

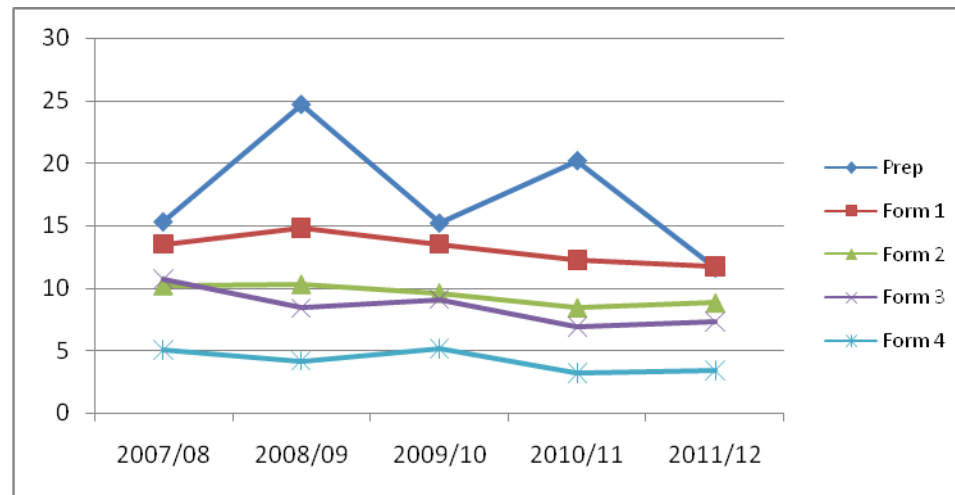

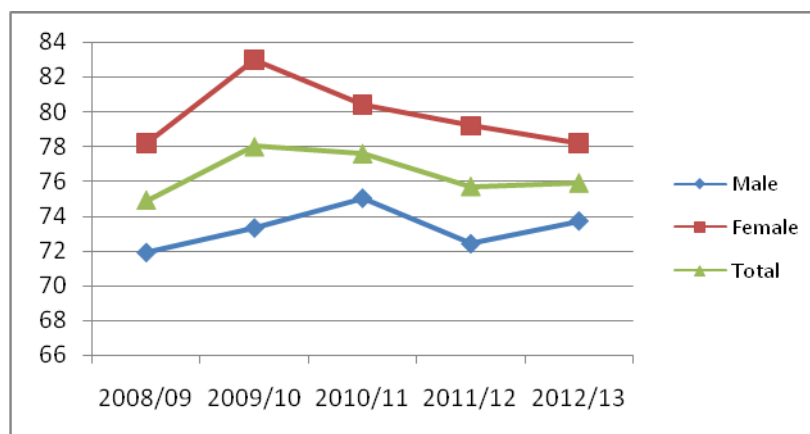

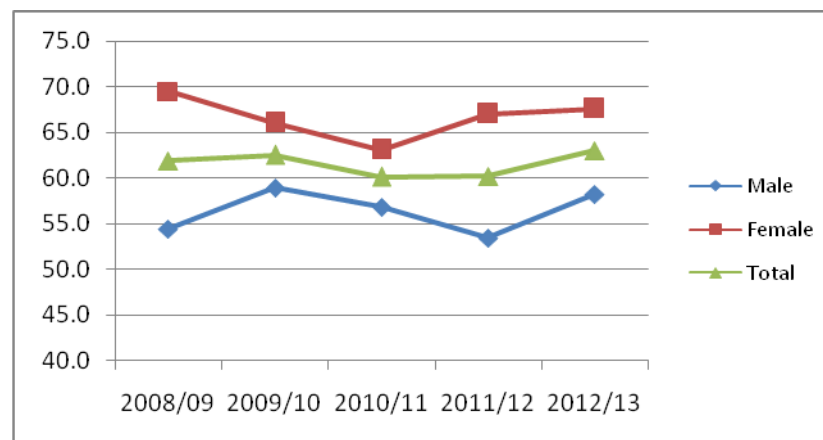

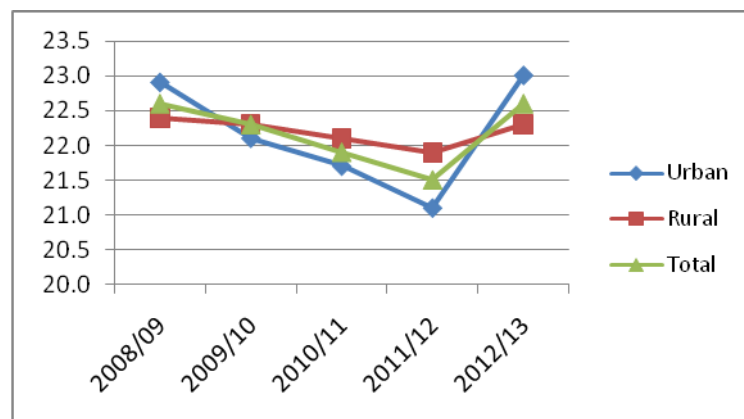

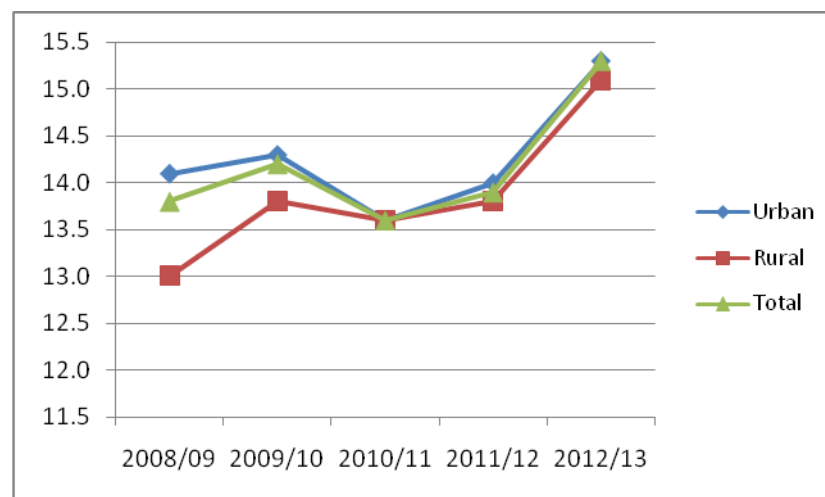

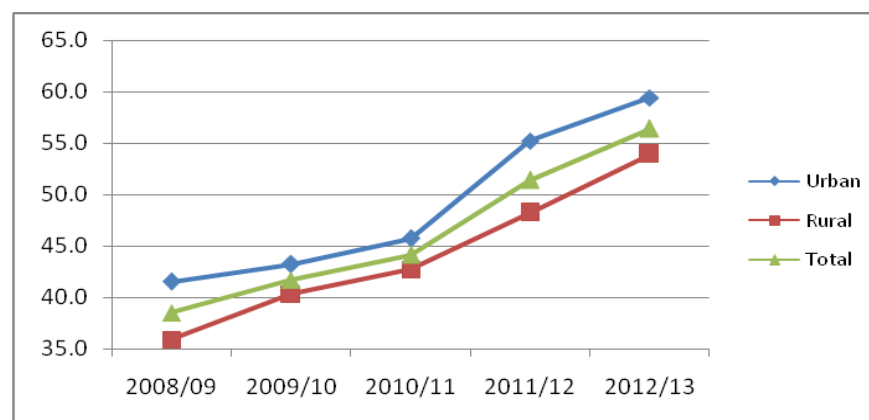

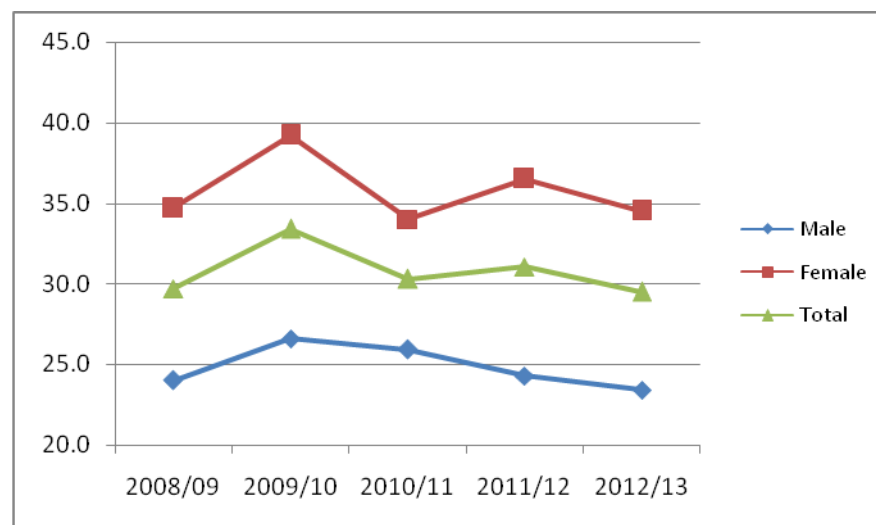

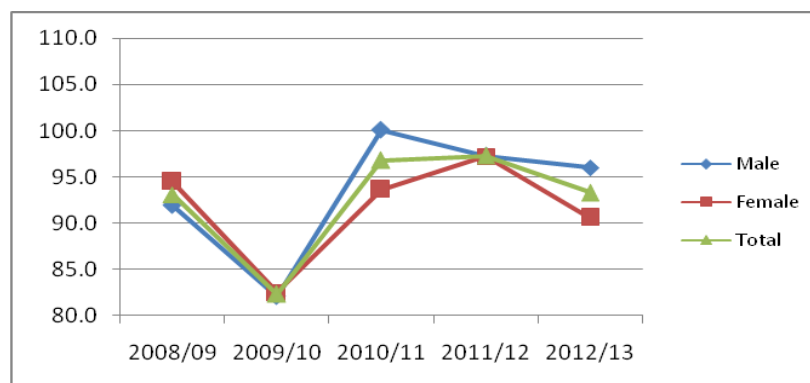

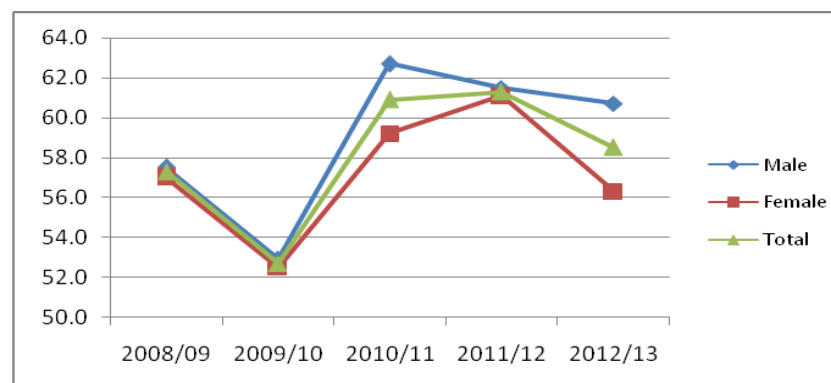

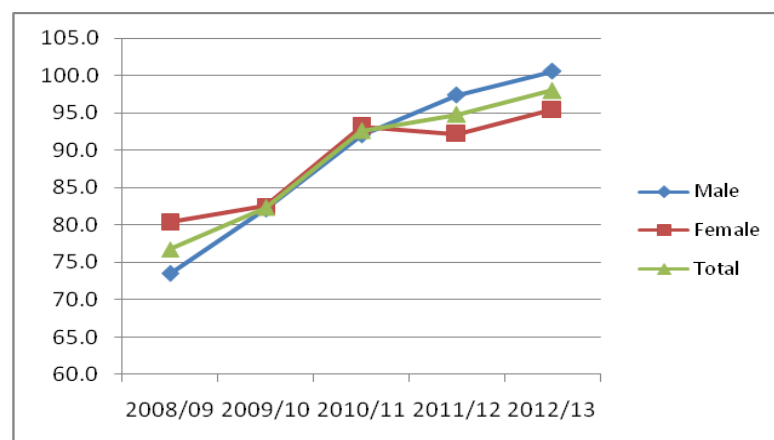

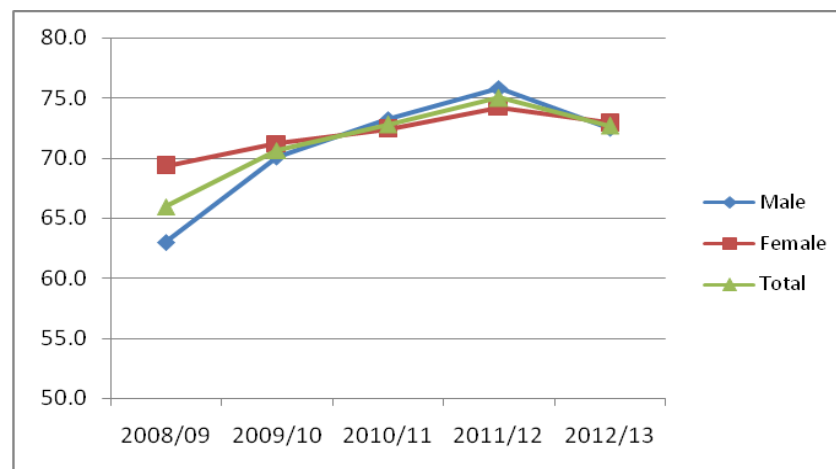
