

THE SANGRE GRANDE DISTRICT.

I. Introduction.

SITUATION.

The Sangre Grande district lies on the east side of the island to the north of the centre line. Its position is shown on map No.1. About 200 square miles in area, (16 miles long by 12 miles wide), it is bounded in the North by the elevated lands of the Northern Range in the Country of St. Andrew; in the east by the coastline; in the south by a ridge of the Central Range, the North Nativá river, and the Nativá Swamp; in the west by the Aripo river to the north and the Arena and Tumpuna Reserves to the south.
