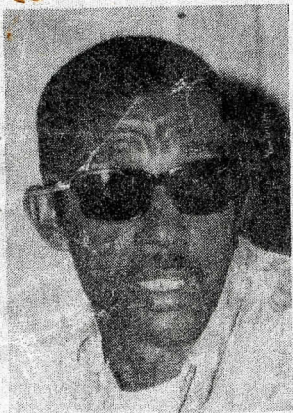

Godard... a "miscalculation"

# Panorama mixup - Invaders in line-up

THE Shell Invaders Steelband is in the semi-finals of the 1969 Steelband and Panorama Competition.

Yesterday an apologetic Mr. George Godard, president of the Trinidad and Tobago Steelbands Association, pointed out that Invaders' non-inclusion among the 12 bands that qualified in Sunday's preliminaries, had been a "miscalculation" by the association.

# POINTS

According to the points awarded by the judges, Invaders tied with Hatters from San Fernando to gain 237 points out of the total of 300.

As a result, 13 steelbands, including Invaders, will now compete in the Panorama semi-finals to come off tomorrow night at the Queen's Park Savannah, subject to the approval of the Carnival Development Committee co-sponsors of the show.

## RESULTS

The final results are as follows:

West Indian Tobacco Gay Desperadoes, 252; Guinness Cavaliers, 250; Solo Harmonites, 246; Catelli Trinidad All Stars, 244; Sylvania East Side Symphony, 242; Forsyth Hilanders, 240; Coca Cola Silver Stars, 238.

Hatters, 237; Invaders, 237; Texaco Dixieland, 236; Angostura Starlift, 230; Paramount Renegades, 230; Valley Harps, 222.

The other bands scored less than 219 points.

"The association wishes to apologise to the Shell Invaders for any embarrassment we may have caused them," said Mr. Goddard.
