

Pan Trinbago to amend constitution 7

STEELBANDSMEN affiliated to Pan Trinbago will be given opportunity to submit amendments to the existing constitution through a series of meetings which will be held in venues throughout Trinidad and Tobago.

Mr Melville Bryan secretary of Pan Trinbago said: "We intend a programme of action. This we believe will streamline the efficient running of the movement, strengthen Pan Trinbago, aid progressive planning, and keep to the desires which have been expressed in the convention."

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Concerning the latter, Mr. Bryan suggested "All steelbands are urged to submit their proposals for amendments to the constitution of Pan Trinbago by Friday June 7."

Mr. Bryan advised bands to submit their suggestions directly to Pan Trinbago's office at 74 Queen Street, if they found it convenient to do so.

An executive meeting has been carded to come off on Tuesday June 4 at the head-

quarters, starting at 5 p.m. Later that evening, the Eastern Region meets at the Arima Grand Stand at 7. p.m.

The Central Region meets at the Polytechnic School of Commerce building in Montrose, Chaguanas at 7 p.m, and the Northern Region at the Old Eastern Market in Port of Spain at 9.30 a.m. on Sunday June 9.

On Sunday June 16, the Southern Region's meeting will take place at Skinner's Park, San Fernando, from 10 a.m.
