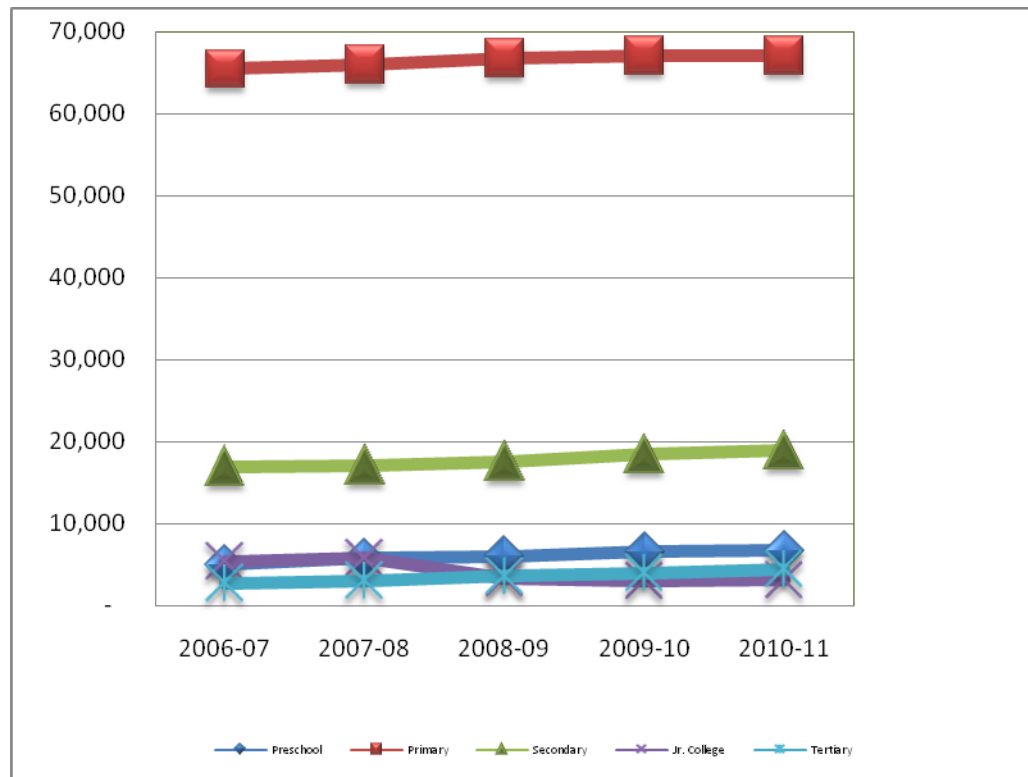

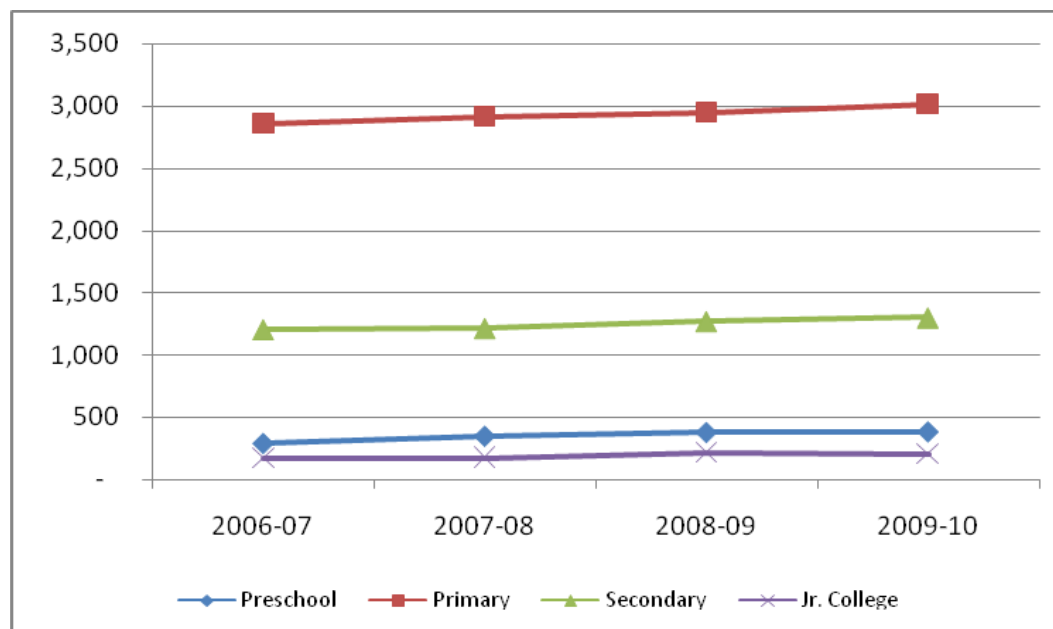

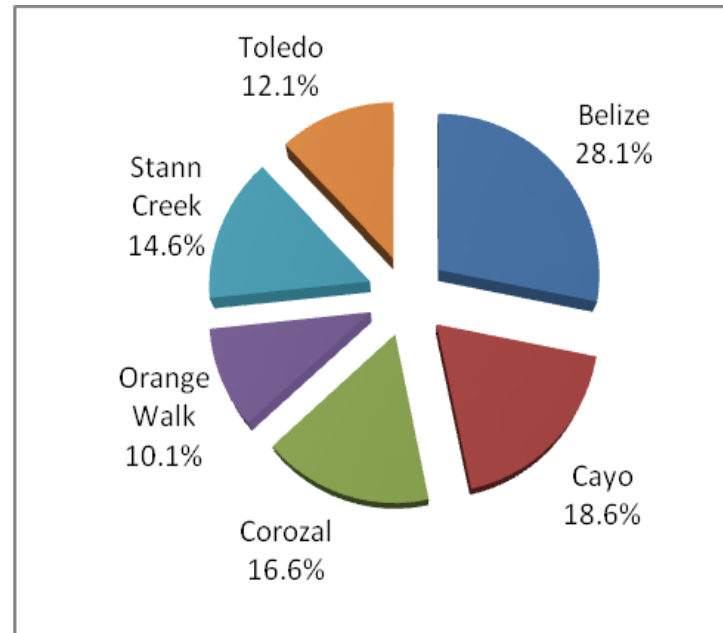

Figure 4: Distribution of Preschool by District 2010-11





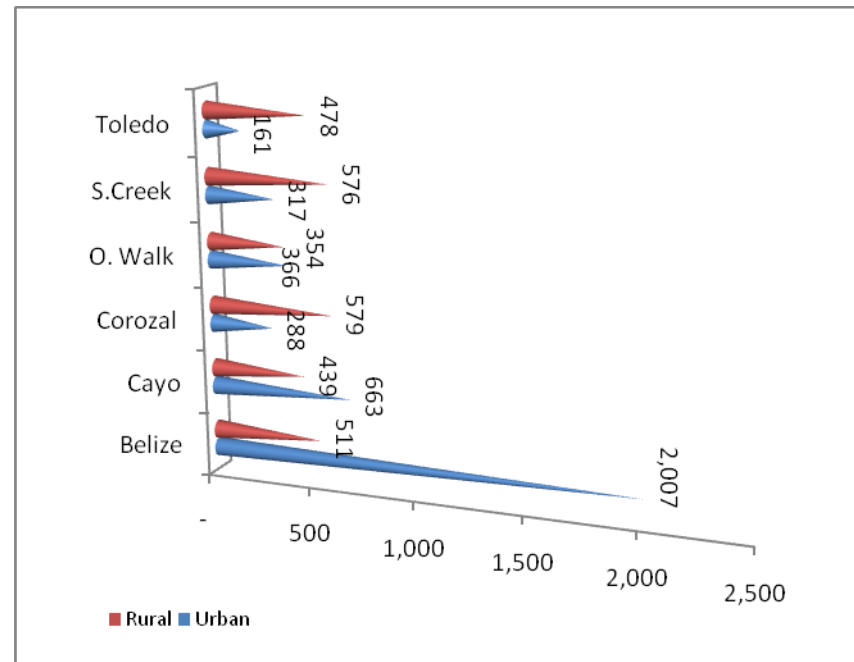

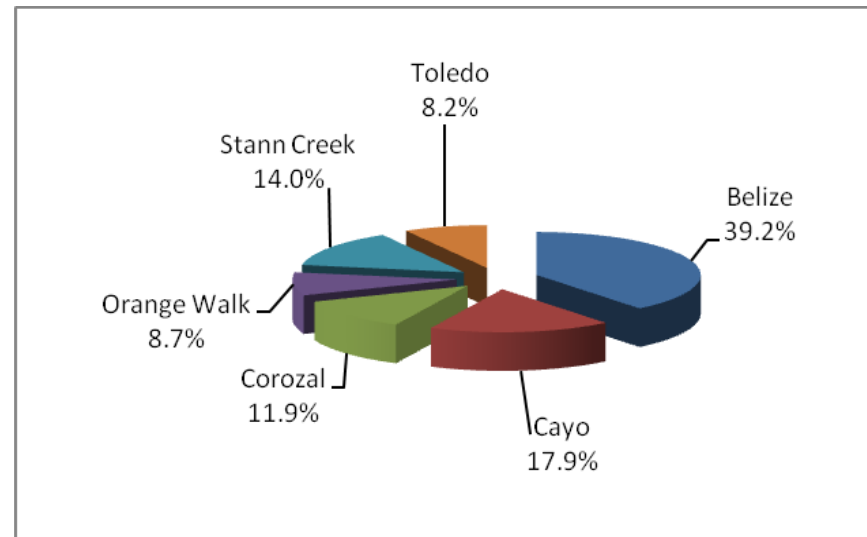

Figure 7: Distribution of Primary School by District and Urban/Rural Location 2010-11

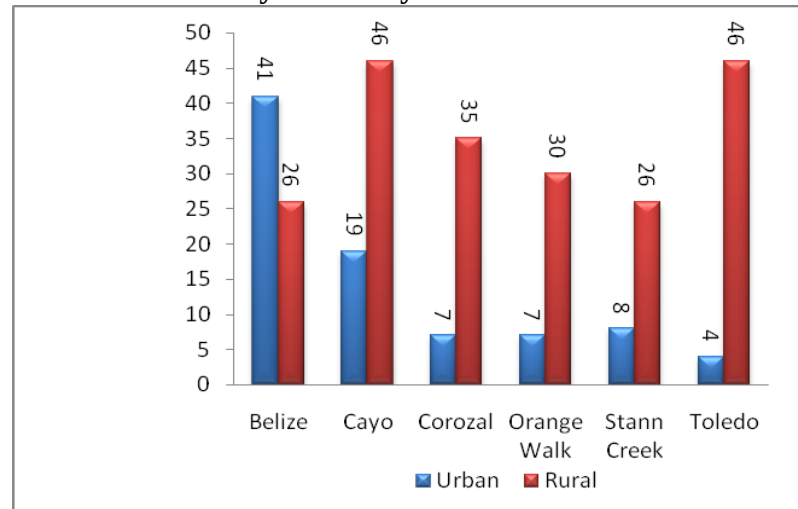
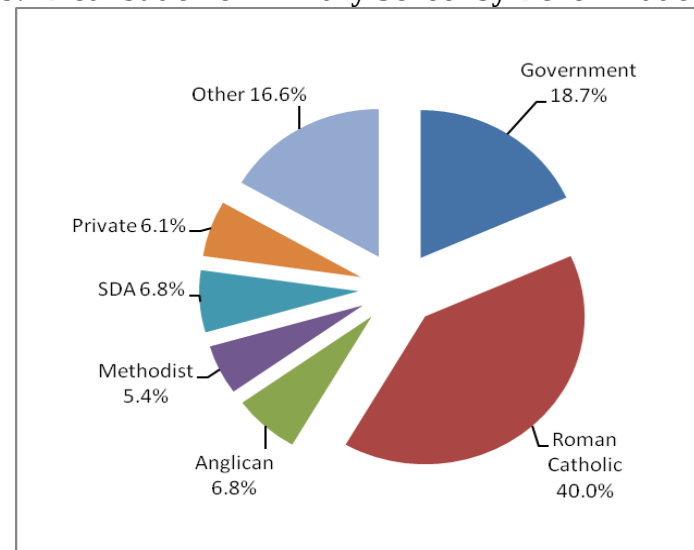


Figure 8: Distribution of Primary School by Denomination 2010-11

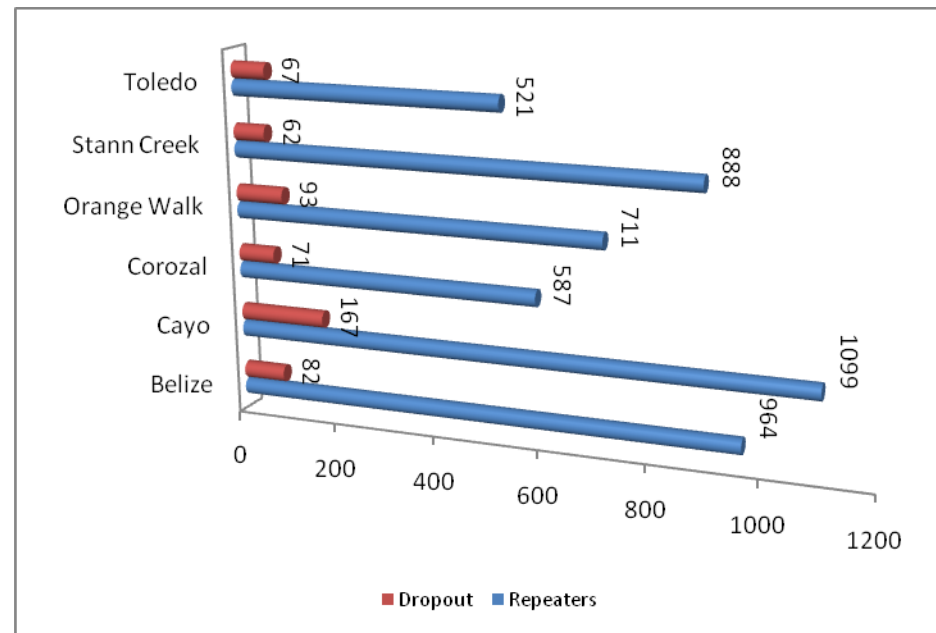

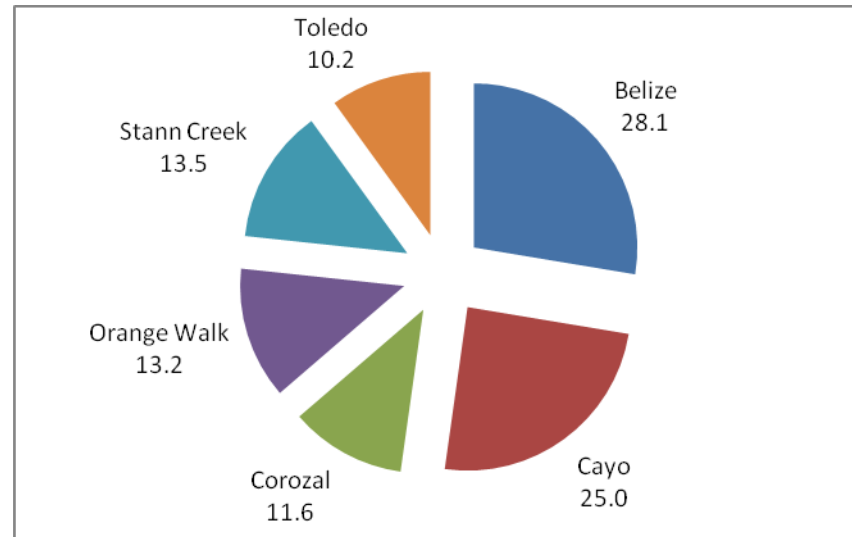

Figure 10: Distribution of Primary School Teachers by District 2010-11

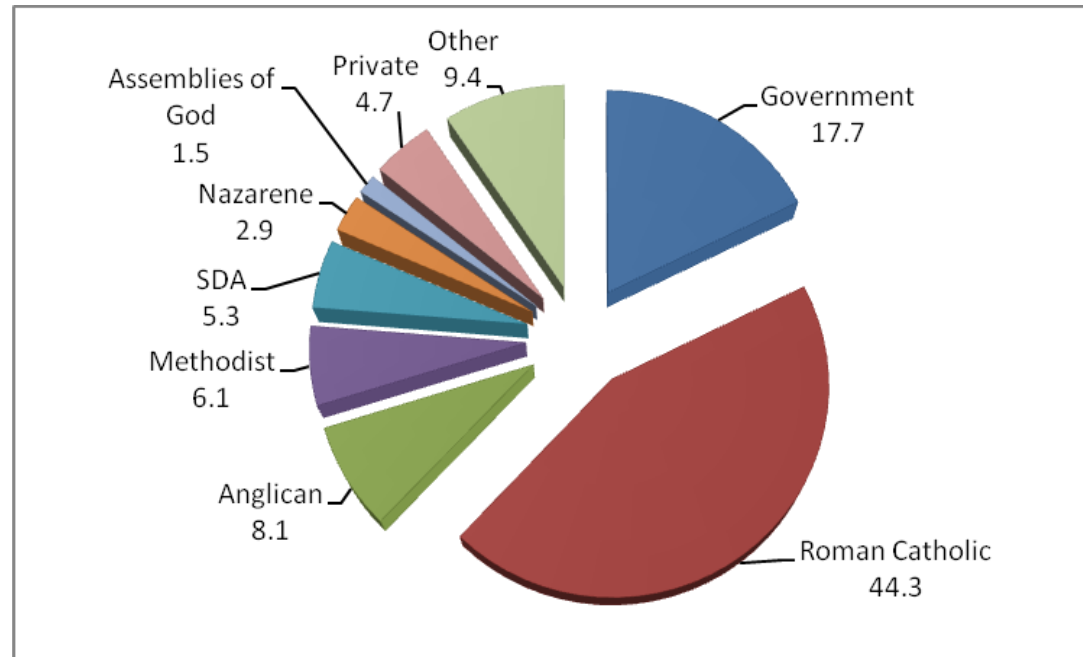

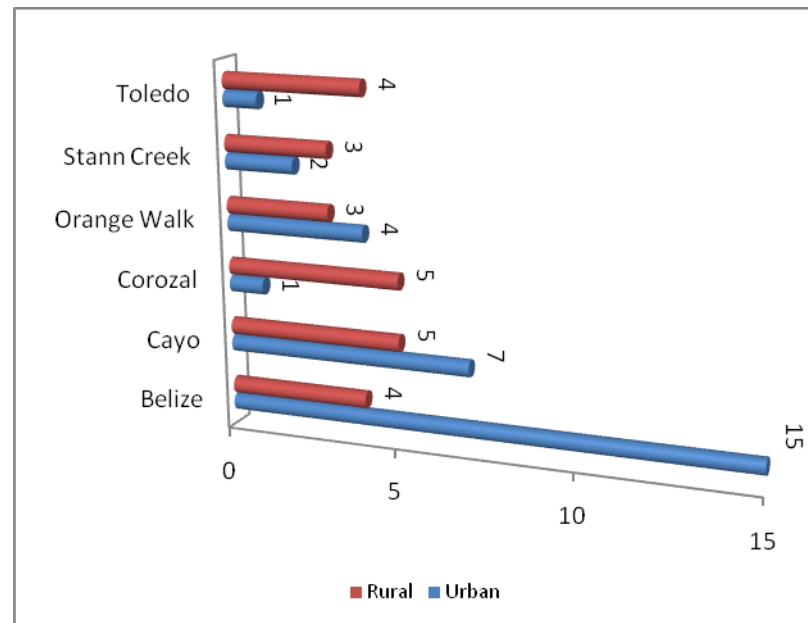

Figure 12: Distribution of Secondary Schools by District and Urban/Rural Location 2010-11

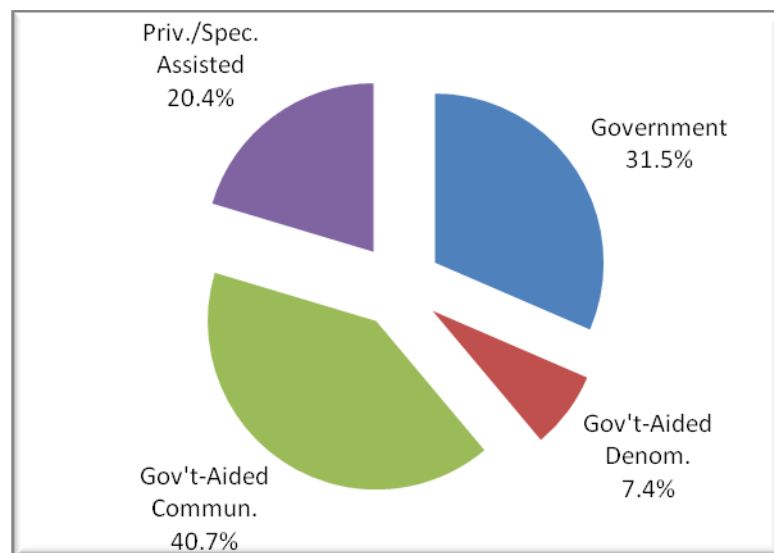

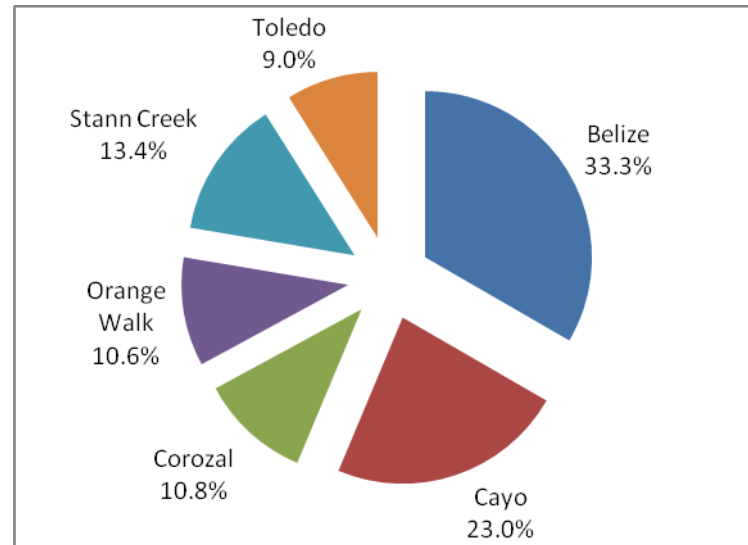

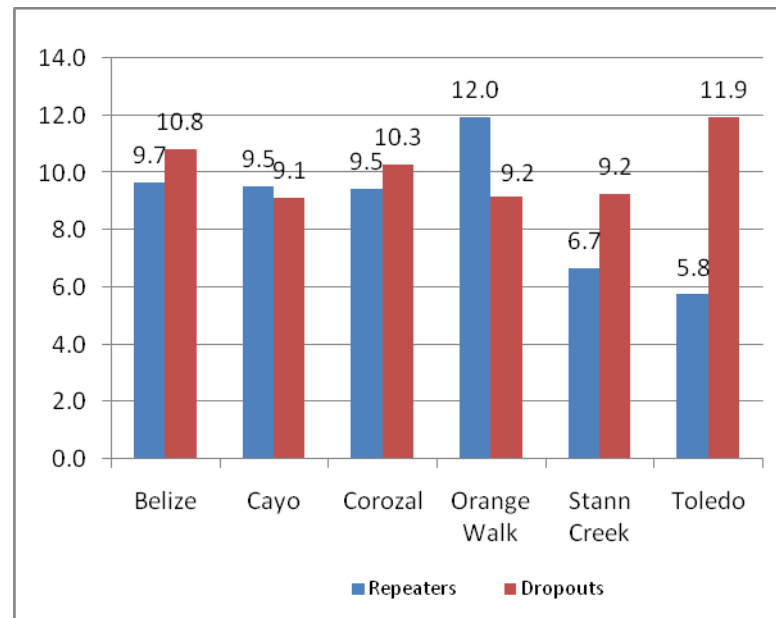

Figure 16: Qualifications of Secondary School Teachers 2010-11

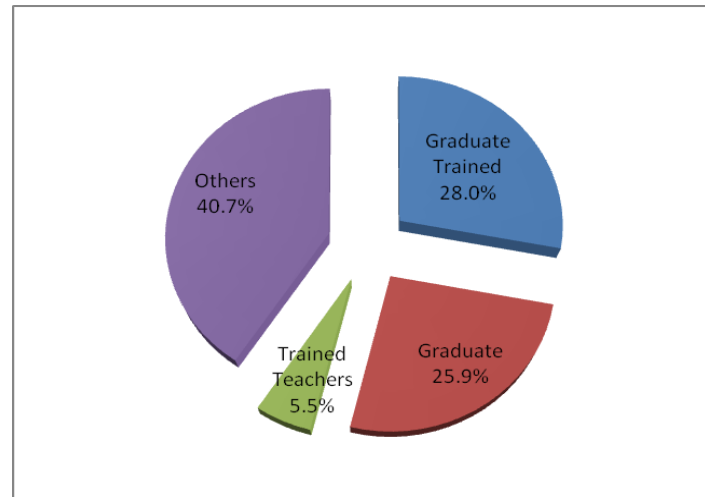
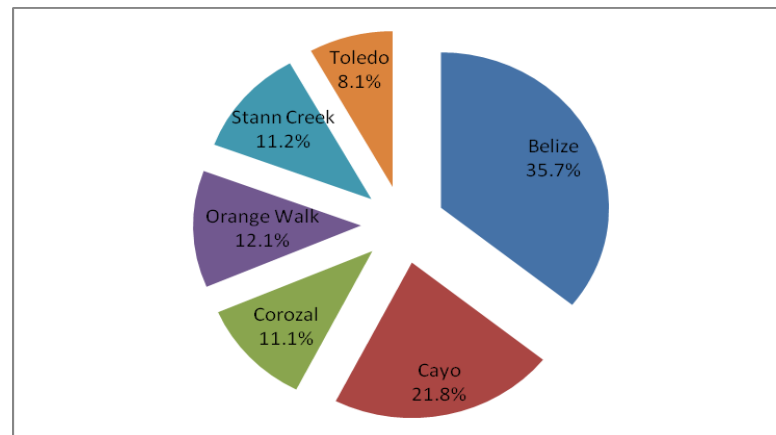


Figure 17: Distribution of Secondary School Teachers by District 2010-11

Figure 18: GOB Recurrent Expenditure by Ministry 2010-11

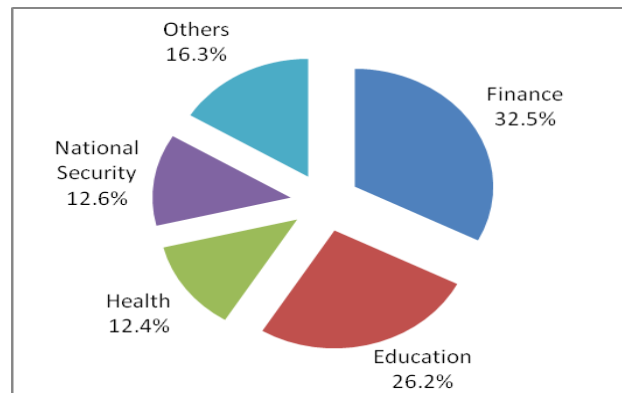


Figure 19: Ministry of Education Recurrent Expenditure by Sub-sector 2010-11

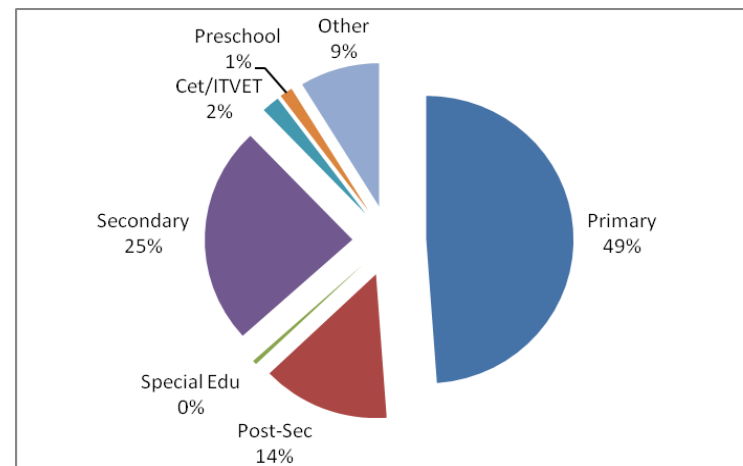




Figure 20: Distribution of Ministry of Education Capital Budget 2010-11

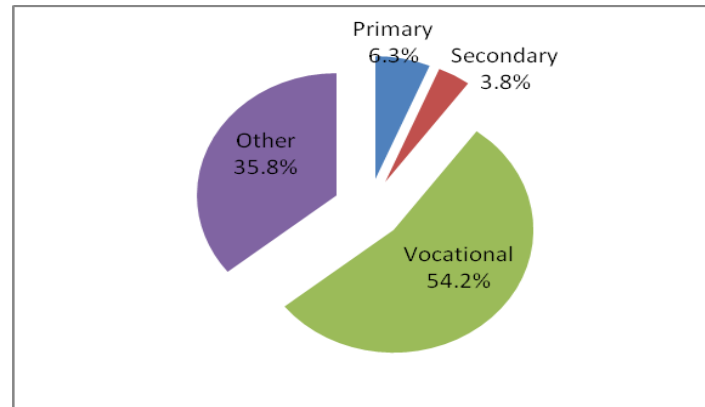
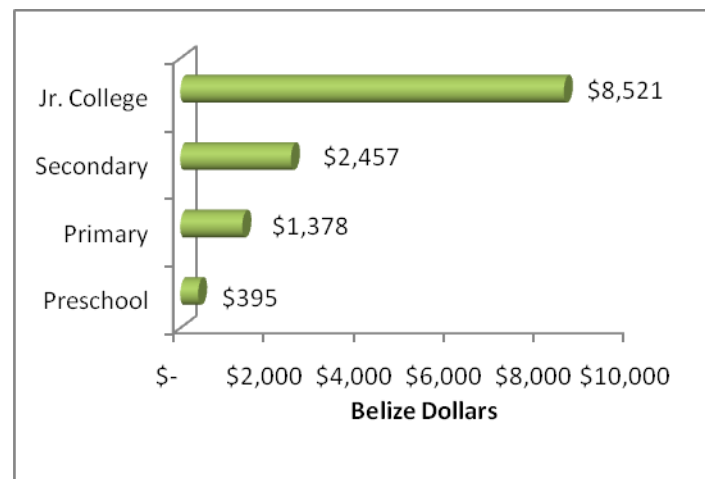


Figure 21: MOES Recurrent Spending Per Student by Level of Education 2010-11

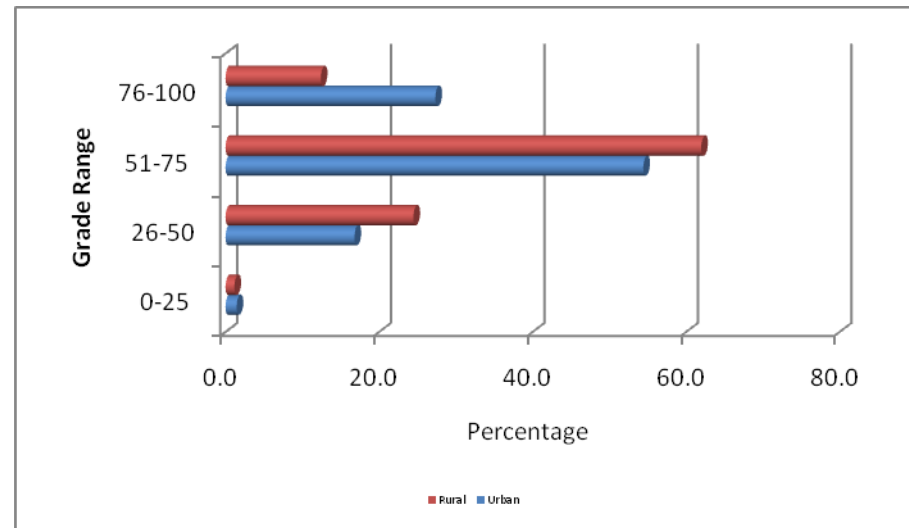
