

# PANORAMA JUDGES GOOF

Judges made a mistake in totalling points from Panorama preliminaries.

After re-checking Phase II Pan Groove has moved up the ranks, from fifth to second place.

A recount by the judges showed that the

Woodbrook band scored 464 points, tying with Trintoc Invaders also of Woodbrook. Phase II had initially been counted for 446 points.

These two bands fall just one point behind reigning champions Tesoro Starlift of

Woodbrook. Starlift's rendition of the Mighty Sparrow's "Robot" bought them 465 points.

Nine points behind were WITCO Gay Desperadoes with 445 points, followed by Solo Harmonites, 450.

The other 13 bands:

Carib Tokyo (445), UWI Birdsong (445), TEC Power Stars (442), Catelli All Stars (432), Antillean All Stars (430), Casablanca (430), Pandemonium (427), Hillside Symphony (424), Amoco Renegades (422), Sforzata (419), Blue Diamonds (415), Flamingoes (413) and South Stars (409).

George Goddard, president of Pan Trnabago, said judges had named 18 bands instead of the 16 requested so there was no guarantee that all 18 bands would take part in the National semi-finals.

Bands which have qualified for the North finals are: Tesoro Starlift, Trintoc Invaders, WITCO Gay Desperadoes, Phase II Pan Groove, Carib Tokyo, T and TEC Power Stars, Catelli All Stars and Casablanca.

For the East finals: Solo Harmonites, UWI Birdsong, Sforzata, Lever Brothers Gay Flamingoes, Sylvania Potential, Cordettes, Nutones and Scherzando.

Judges chose six pen-around-the-neck bands: Gay Hoytonians (417), Skiffle Bunch (415), Ready mix Sound Masters (396), Crown Supersonics (392), Chordmasters (380) and High Larks (349).

Meanwhile, the draw for the South Zone preliminaries will take place at the San Fernando Town Hall today at 5.30 p.m.
