

Six resign from Pan Trinbago

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SIX officials of Pan Trinbago, four of them from the Executive, have resigned.

Their resignations were accepted at a special convention held on Sunday at the Communication Workers' Union Hall on Henry Street, Port-of-Spain.

As a result, members of steelbands in Pan Trinbago have been asked to submit the names of interested persons desirous of serving on the organisation's executive as replacements.

The convention will be resumed in the next two weeks to fill the vacancies.

The six who have resigned are: Nestor Sullivan, vice-president; Andre Moses, education officer; Clifton Greene, trustee; Mitchum Cunningham, chairman of the Eastern Region and Regional Co-ordinator; Eden Charles, trustee; and Keith Castor, regional representative.
