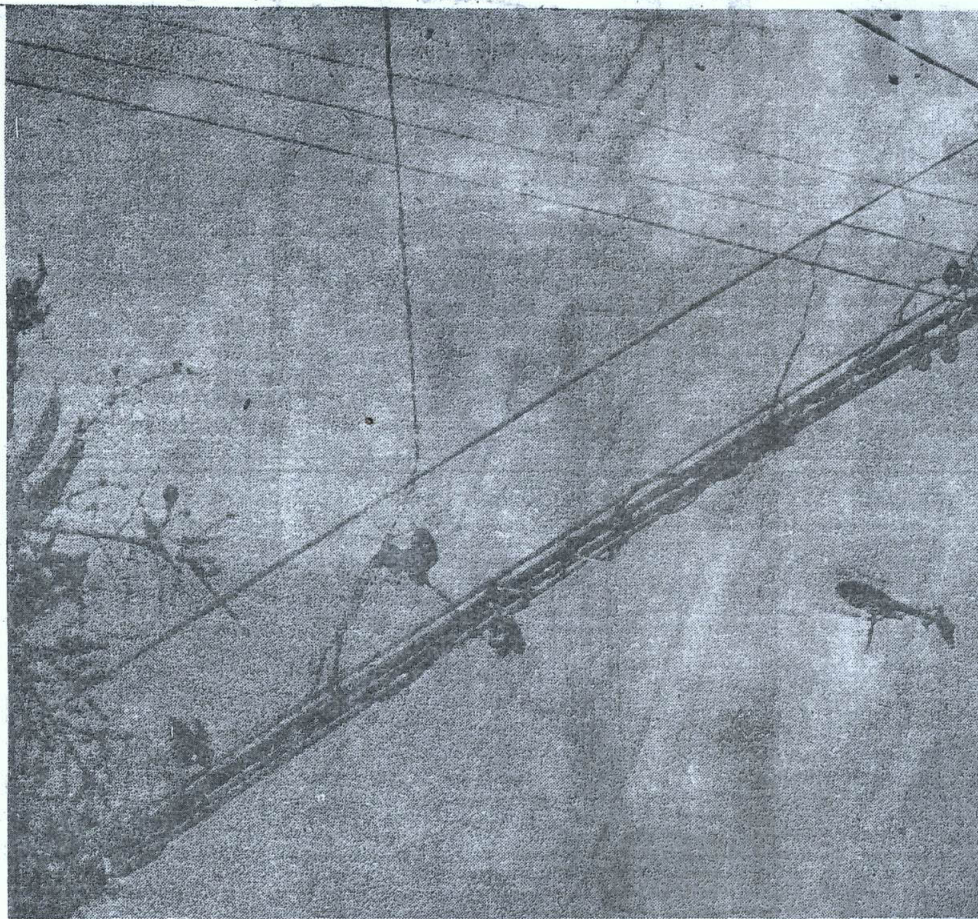


South panmen support boycott
