King contest February 29

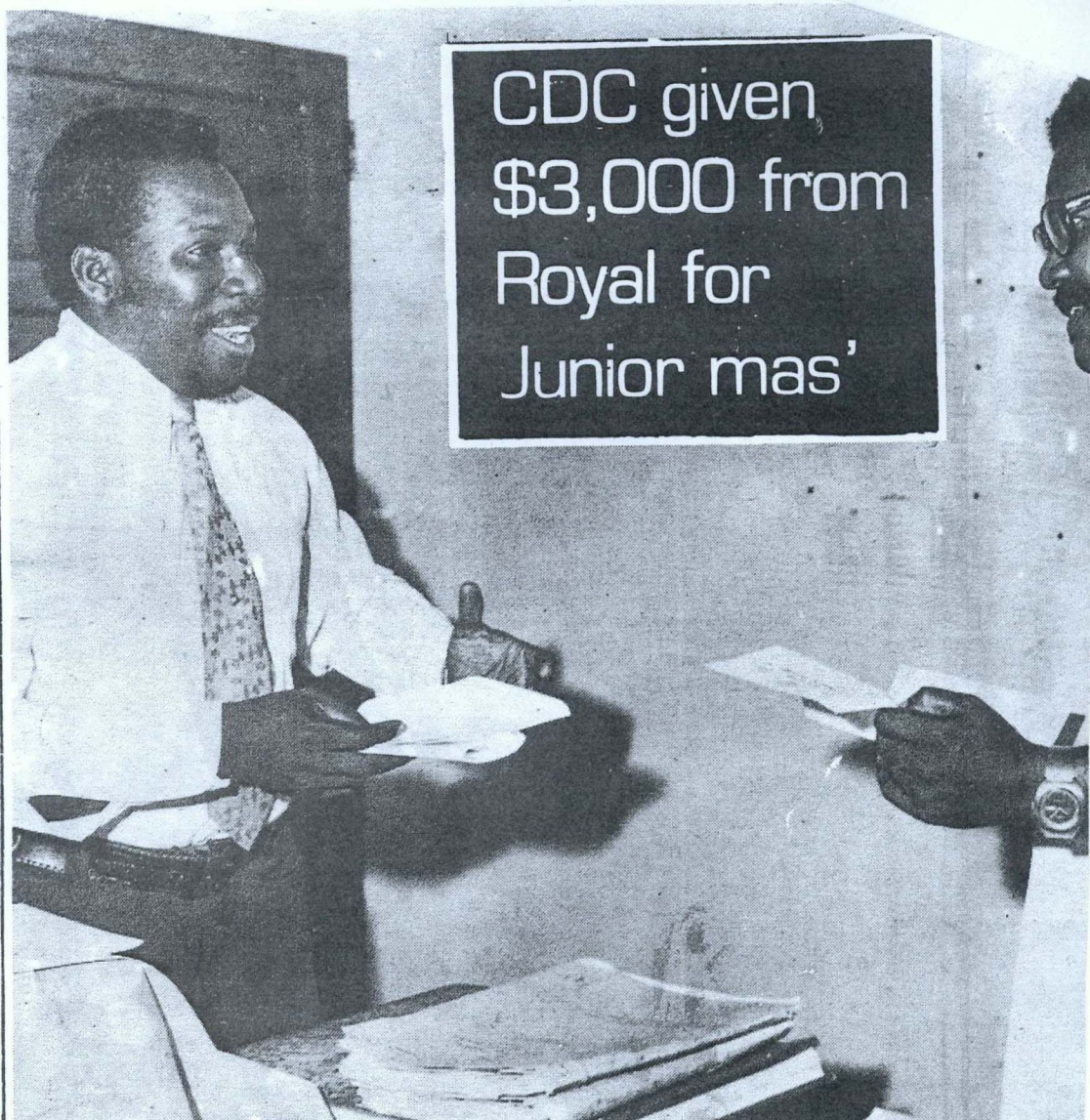
THE revived North Calypso King Contest organised by the Calypsonians' Association, will be held February 29.
