

Objects of the Survey.

The primary objectives of the survey were as follows:

(1) To obtain, as accurately as possible, the acreage devoted to food gardens in the area surveyed.

(11) To determine the constituents of these food gardens, i.e. the actual crops grown, and to obtain some measure of their relative importance within the gardening system.

(111) The collection of as much secondary information about these crops as possible, i.e. the methods of husbandry, such as manurial and rotation practices, use of combinations, method of disposal, etc., and any other details which might prove of interest such as difference in gardening practices between racial groups of operators (gardeners).
