HARMONITES GETS \$50,000 FROM GOVT

A government grant of \$50,000 has been awarded to the Solo Harmonites Steel Orchestra, a whitehall press release said yesterday.

The sum represents 50 per cent of the cost of a Pan Theatre-cum-Community Centre to be established by the members of the band.

The money will be taken

from the Culture Fund on the recommendation of the Minister of Sport, Culture and Youth Affairs, Marilyn Gordon (PNM-Arouca).

The theatre will be located on the site now occupied by the band at the junction of Fourth Street and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway at Barataria.
