



**THE COLUMBUS ANCHOR**  
 Recovered from the sea at Beaufort, Trinidad where this Anchor is believed to have belonged to one of the caravels of Admiral Christopher Columbus who discovered the island on Tuesday 1st July 1498. By Sir D. Fitzmaurice, Governor, July 1858. One of the Anchors in the Secretary's Mouth a few days later. This Anchor was deposited in 1858 in the Garden of the Anchor in 1858 and in 1901.
