THIRTY-ONE members of the University of the West Indies, Mona, Jamaica, graduating medical class of August 1982, and their spouses, celebrated their 35th anniversary reunion in Trinidad.

The group sampled local cuisine, culture and also explored several places that even some Trinis in the group had not visited previously.
