Tourists on last leg of world tour

EIGHTY-THREE tourists and travel agents from Denmark flew out of Piarco Airport yesterday afternoon after a two-day stay at the Hotel Normandie.

The group is on the last leg of a world tour arranged by Tjaereborg Agency, the biggest travel agency in Scandinavia, which owns and operates Sterling Airways, a fleet of 13 private charter airplanes.

The tour took them to Egypt, India, Thailand, Hong Kong, Japan, Hawaii, San Francisco and Mexico.

From Trinidad, the group will visit Morocco and then back home.
