Heartened by the success of the first open-air meeting at Woodford Square on Monday last, which inaugurated the drive for funds to help send a representative steel orchestra to the Festival of Britain, the Trinidad and Tobago Steel Bands Association will be holding two open-air meetings at the Belmont Square and Woodbrook playground, respectively, to further the publicity drive.

There will be a steel band festa at the Woodbrook Stadium on April 30, at which the Invaders, City Syncopators, Rising Sun and Tripoli steel bands will perform. These bands will be assisted by popular calypsonians.

Mr. Theodore "Theo" Williams, virtuoso of the Free French Steel Band, has accepted the invitation of the association to join the representative steel band members now rehearsing at the Cocorite Youth Centre.
