Pan Trinbago: Rallying days over

PAN Trinbago yesterday said they could account for all monies received in respect of Panorama last year.

President of the association Melville Bryan, said that they had presented 1977 Panorama accounts to the Auditor-General's Department, before funds to clear their debts, were released.

He said Government had requested an account on condition it be audited by the Auditor-General's Department.

He said "Pan Trinbago has shown that the solution to problems can be found without ostentation or show. The days for rallying for support by loudmouthing are past," he added.

After going through the association's accounts and holding several meetings with the Joint Management Committee, Government had allocated \$199,000 for Pan Trinbago to clear debts.
