12. Crazy - "Carla".

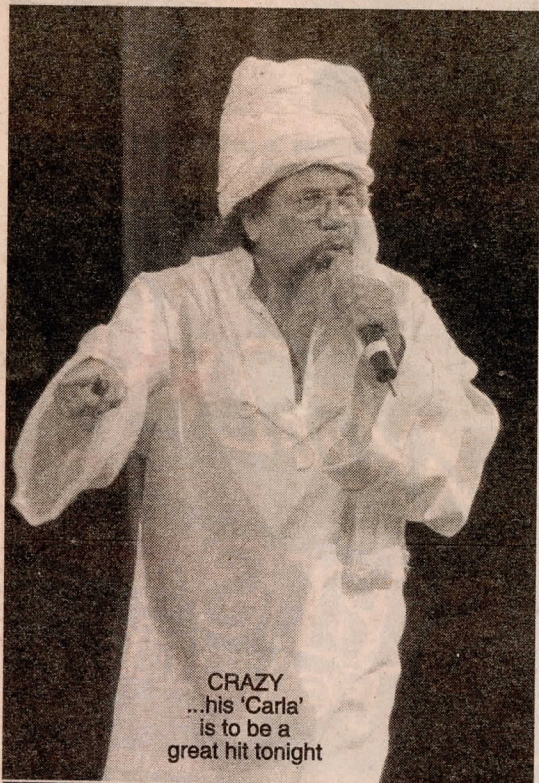
For this year's Pan Kaiso competition, all contestants will be accompanied by a full steelband
