

## INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this work was to study the weed nut-grass (Cyperus rotundus L.) with a view to finding out any information which might be of use in devising a method of controlling it under the conditions of Trinidad.

Two lines of approach were adopted:

1. An attempt was made to estimate the seriousness of nut-grass as a weed, due to the dearth of literature on this subject.
2. A rough trial of one of the more promising methods of control was conducted.
