### **Workshop Abstract:**

Research4Life provides free or low-cost online access to leading journals and books in the fields of health, agriculture, environment, applied sciences and law, delivering knowledge to reduce the gap between high-income countries and low and middle-income countries.

This workshop will provide understanding of five programs within Research4Life - Research in Health (Hinari), Research in Agriculture (AGORA), Research in the Environment (OARE), Research for Development and Innovation (ARDI) and Research for Global Justice (GOALI). Presenters will demonstrate how to access the content, provide understanding of the differences between the databases, doing research, and reading and using the scientific and professional literature.
