

Moon Sammy award goes to Marshall

THE AWARD of the George Moon Sammy Bursary 2016/2017 was made on the January 17 at the offices of Design Engineering Services Ltd.

The bursary is offered each year by the Sammy family in memory of the late Prof George Moon Sammy, who founded the Food Technology Unit, Department of Chemical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering at The University of the West Indies (The UWI).

The recipient of this year's award was Shushanna Marshall, a national of Trinidad and Tobago and a post-graduate student at the university in St Augustine, who graduated obtaining a BSc in Human Ecology – specialised in Food and Food

Service Systems Management and Communication Extension.

Marshall is currently reading part-time for the Master of Science degree in Agri-Food Safety and Quality Assurance in the Department of Food Production at The UWI in St Augustine.

The award is open to all students registered for any post-graduate course in food technology offered by The UWI. They must be nationals of the Caribbean and have a good academic record.

However, the prime criterion for the award is financial need. The award was established in 1988/89 and so far there have been 24 recipients with Shushanna Marshall being the 26th.
