

UWI begins to enforce 'No Thoroughfare'

The University of the West Indies' St Augustine campus began an intensified enforcement of its No Thoroughfare policy on October 5.

This means that from Monday to Friday, only vehicles displaying valid **UWI** vehicle permits are allowed to enter the campus via the North and South Gates. Vehicles without valid permits will be directed to the visitor's entrance at the Daaga Gate accessible along St Augustine Circular Road.

Traffic restrictions also include:

- The section of Lewis Avenue between the visitors' entrance at Daaga Gate and the northern junction of Lewis Avenue with Wooding Drive, will be restricted to one-way vehicular traffic only, from east to west;

- The Administration Gate (Old Biology) will be opened between the hours of 4.30 pm and 5 pm for exit only, in order to alleviate traffic congestion at the North and South Gates.
